

Project Assistant for Re:Collect

Re:Collect India is public archive of science which intends to engage the public in documenting India's rich history of science, technology, and engineering. It facilitates intergenerational conversation which will capture the enthusiasm, challenges, setbacks, struggles and experience of conducting research. It will also help document the process of establishing disciplines, institutions and building equipment in India after independence. These conversations will be preserved in an oral history archive which will become part of the public facing website which will inform future academicians, researchers and creatives.

Role:

- Coordinate and manage the collection of the stories of science and engineering in India since Independence.

Person Specifications:

- Bachelors or Masters in any subject
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Have excellent verbal and written command of English
- Interest in science, history and story-telling

Submission Requirements:

- A one-page cover letter clearly stating the desired position, as well as relevant experience and skills. The cover letter must indicate the period of availability.
- A one-page resume.
- Interested candidates should share a writing sample of 800 words.
- Names and contact details of two referees whom we may contact if required.

General Requirements

Candidates must:

- Be enrolled in a college/ university or be a recent graduate.
- Have excellent verbal and written command of English. Knowledge of Kannada will be an advantage but is not a qualifying condition.

Interns, Research Assistants and Project Assistants are provided a stipend based on experience. Science Gallery Bengaluru is not able to provide information on external sources of funding, travel or accommodation. Applicants are advised to check with their academic institutions for sources of internship funding.

Housing, costs of living, travel costs, and medical insurance connected with the internship program must be borne by interns or by other institutions or organizations. Interns are responsible for arranging their own travel to Bengaluru and accommodation.

How to Apply

The application process is competitive. Applications will be judged on past academic performance, relevant academic study, and work experience. Only qualified applicants will be contacted for interviews.
