CRAFTSMANSHIP FROM BEGINNING TO END

We start with sustainably forested Adirondack Eastern White Pine from a family sawmill. This wood is painstakingly dried in slow kilns, going beyond industry standards to create the most stable planks for interior use. These are then milled to shiplap with traditional 19th century circular sawmarks. Better than simple planks, shiplap can be installed tight for crisp lines or spaced for country style without unsightly gaps.

Finally, we distress and season the finished boards to give them the appearance of beautifully weathered, reclaimed barn wood. For the Artisan Accents Collection, this includes charring and brushing the surface in the manner of the Japanese Shou Sugi Ban method, and sealing it.

The result is pristine wood paneling with true grit that you can feel great about using in your home.

JAPANESE CHARWOOD

A deep, almost inky black, these double-charred planks feature a combination of crackled and rippled texture exemplary of the Shou Sugi Ban style. Dramatic, and equally at home in modern or arts-and-crafts applications.



19th CENTURY BARNWOOD

This is the poster child for our philosophy of using authentic hands-on craft. Charring, whitewashing, and wire-brushing results in a rich tobacco brown laced with an eroded white paint pattern that highlights the circle-sawn texture. This style arose with the invention of the circular saw in the 1800's, before the advent of modern machining in 20th century sawmills.

(MURDER IN THE) RED BARN

An incredibly versatile take on a classic barn red. Charring gives this board rare depth of color and results in a lacquer-like brick-toned finish that changes with the light.

SPECIFICATIONS: 25 square foot coverage per box (14 planks) allowing 1/8" visible relief, or 24 square feet without. Each plank approximately 3/8" x 5-1/2" x 48". As natural materials finished to impart character, color and appearance varies. Every piece is unique.
