Uniform Logo

PLEASE shop <u>only</u> from the vendor's uniform department and check to be sure that the item is on our approved list.

GIRLS:

Tops for Girls

- **Required RED COMPASS shirt/dress** which is to be worn on field trips and on Wednesdays for chapel
- Tops: Light Blue, White or Red
 - Must have CMDS Compass or House Logo
 - House Logos are available on light blue and white polo tops
- Tops for jumpers can include white peter pan blouse without a logo. Tops must be worn under jumpers.

Bottoms for Girls

- Khaki/navy bottoms pants, shorts, skirts or skorts
- Polo dress with <u>CMDS Compass or House Logo</u>
 - House Logos are available on light blue polo dresses
- Khaki/navy jumper or dress with <u>CMDS Compass or House Logo</u>
 - House Logos are available on khaki jumpers and dresses
- CMDS plaid jumper
- CMDS plaid bottoms
- Black, navy or white leggings (plain with no decoration)
- Girls may wear tights or knee socks (black, navy or white)

BOYS:

Tops for Boys

- Required RED COMPASS shirt which is to be worn on field trips and on Wednesdays for chapel
- Tops: Light Blue, White or Red
 - Must have CMDS Compass or House Logo
 - House Logos are on available on light blue and white polo tops

Bottoms for Boys

• Khaki/navy bottoms – uniform pants or shorts

In addition, the following regulations apply to Grades SK-6th:

- 1. Boys' shirttails must be tucked in. Younger boys wearing elastic shorts must tuck in their shirts.
- 2. Belts must be worn with pants or shorts with belt loops.
- 3. Any belt is allowed (brown, black, CMDS, college teams or other prints).
- 4. Socks must be worn. Socks must be 90% black or white. Small colored logos/stripes are allowed. Spirit Store socks are allowed.
- 5. Tennis shoes are to be worn every day.
- 6. No flip-flops, sandals, high heels, open-toed shoes, boots or clogs are allowed.
- 7. No hats are allowed (except on "Hat Day" or outside hats for very cold weather days).
- 8. Clear mascara, light colored lip gloss and concealer are allowed. Foundation, dark mascara, blush and eyeshadow should not be worn.
- 9. Boys' hair must be worn above the collar. Boys may not wear earrings.
- 10. Extreme hairstyles are not allowed. Hair may not obstruct the eyes.
- 11. Girls' shorts, skorts, skirt and dress length should be no shorter than 4 inches above the back of the knee. Be sure to measure the hemline several times during the year. If in doubt, don't wear it.
- 12. T-shirts worn under uniform shirts must be solid white. The t-shirt sleeves should not be visible.
- 13. Unusual or new styles that occur will be addressed on an individual basis.
- 14. For INSIDE wear, as part of the school uniform, students may wear:
 - Navy or red fleece jacket with Compass Logo
 - Navy or red sweatshirt with Compass Logo
 - CMDS plaid monogram sweatshirt
 - Navy or red fleece jacket or vest with Compass Logo
 - Approved CMDS Spirit Store Clothing
 - CMDS House sweatshirts
 - Solid color red or white sweater/sweater vest with the Compass Logo.
 - Sweatshirts must have the school logo, crest or CMDS monogram and should be worn over a collared shirt.
- 15. For OUTSIDE wear, students may wear any appropriate coat, sweater or sweatshirt.
- 16. Members of Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts may wear the scout uniform only on the last meeting day of the month.

Consequences for being out of uniform include use of the conduct system and contact with parents. Students are expected to arrive at school in compliance with all aspects of the dress code. T-shirt days, red Compass shirt days, sweatshirt days and/or jeans days will remain in effect as scheduled.

Students will receive one warning a quarter for dress code violations related to belts, socks, non-CMDS apparel in the building, etc. After the warning, they will receive a dress code violation slip from an administrator. Violations of the makeup policy will result in automatic dress code violation slips.

Each dress code violation slip counts as one point off the conduct grade. 3 dress code violations equal a conduct slip.
