Online Communion during First Sunday Fellowship: On **Sunday, Sept 6**, Eden UCC will offer a Communion service during our 11 am Fellowship time on Zoom. Everyone is invited to tune in to participate in this important Sacrament. You'll need to provide yourself and your family with bread (bread, crackers, or cookies) and wine (wine, grape juice, milk, or water). Then join us at 11 am for our first Communion since we began sheltering in place.

Curious about the meaning of Communion in the United Church of Christ? As practiced in the UCC today, "blessing the bread as Jesus blessed" has many different meanings. We celebrate it as a table of remembrance where the bread and the cup stand as reminders of the life, death, resurrection, and continuing presence of the living Christ through the Holy Spirit. It is also an act of thanksgiving for the renewal of our lives here and the assurance of God's forgiveness.

Often it celebrated as a foretaste of the Great Banquet to come at the final conclusion of God's story as well as a celebration of God's grace. Other meanings include liberation (as a continuation of the Last Supper's origin as a Passover Feast) and unity (as expression of our oneness in Christ and our fellowship with one another). And almost always, regardless of what meaning we bring to it, it is a time of self-examination and personal petition.

We practice "open communion" at Eden Church, which means that you do not have to be a member of this church or of any church to participate in this sacred meal. You need only to desire a closer relationship with the One who is our host.

Roanoke Revival: Our favorite bluegrass band, Roanoke Revival, is scheduled to play for worship on **Sunday, Sept 6** (Labor Day Weekend).

ChYLIS & My Eden Voice Speakout on Rent Relief: My Eden Voice, of which Eden Church is a member organization, launched a campaign demanding rent relief for our area, one of the highest COVID-impacted and most economically challenged areas in the Alameda County. Naturally, the ChYLIs jumped on board, getting digital petition signatures and educating the neighborhood about the issue. This Tuesday the ChYLIs delivered public comments at the Alameda County Board of Supervisors meeting advocating for the extension of the Eviction Moratorium and CARES funding for Eden Area Rent Relief. We are happy to report that the Board of Supervisors voted to extend the Eviction Moratorium through at least December 31, 2020! We continue to advocate for additional rent relief for the Eden Area.

This coming Wednesday, Aug 12 will be the ChYLIs final session. They will be recording their Solidarity projects in Oliver Hall. Be on the lookout for a video recapping their memorable **2020 cohort!**

JOYS

The **Cherryland Computer Café** Team exceeded their goals as a contracted Census Assistance Center with Alameda County Census Complete Count Committee. We were able to share information about the census with **more than 4,000 people** since October 2019. Most importantly, our team alone has ensured that Alameda County will receive at least **\$15,000,000** in federal funding for essential services over the next decade, as due to our efforts, more than **1,500** in our census tracts have been counted. Thanks all who ensure that the Eden Area Counts! **On July 28 were also selected by Alameda County Board of Supervisors for a services contract extension, granting the CCC an additional \$35,000**.

The **extension** (until December 31, 2020) on the **Eviction Moratorium** was approved by the Alameda County Board of Supervisors this past Tuesday. Two of our ChYLIs addressed the Board during public comments and advocated for passage of the proposal.

Eden's heartfelt congratulations goes out to our bookkeeper, **Alicia Oseguera**, and her husband, **Oskar Leonel Bgñ Otz**, who were married in Mexico on July 25, 2020.

Eden Church has shared emergency relief funds with Ashland, Cherryland, Hayward Acres, and San Lorenzo residents, through generous gifts from the following organizations: **East Bay Community Foundation (\$25,000)** and **The San Francisco Foundation (\$10,000)**.

We also shared **\$10,000** in emergency relief funds with Strobridge Elementary School Families through a grant from the **Strobridge Elementary School PTA**.

This past week, Eden Church received a **\$5,000** grant from the **United Way of the Bay Area** to continue to provide COVID-Relief to the Unincorporated Communities.

Eden Church has been awarded a **\$50,000** contract to provide essential groceries, diapers and baby wipes, and cleaning supplies for families resident in Unincorporated South Alameda County Housing by the Alameda County Community Development Department.

For new partnerships with the Alameda County First-Five, Ashland Community Market & Café, Eden Township Health District, Mandela Partners, The Daily Bowl, and the USDA for fresh produce, personal protective equipment, cleaning supplies, and infant and toddler supplies!

For the 30 volunteers and all of the funds raised to provide **over 5,000 meals for UIY students** with a home cooked supper 6 days per week and a care package for the weekend. Meals were prepared by volunteer chefs in the Oliver Hall Kitchen and transported for pick-up at Tennyson High School HUSD, and for delivery in the Tennyson High School community & delivered to UIY homes in the Cherryland Elementary School community for the past 2 months. This program served as a bridge to invite UIY participation in California's Pandemic EBT program, which provides nutritious food for students without SS#s, for the coming year.
