Congratulations to *Liam Vetrovec*, who received his Fifth Grade Bible from Eden Church during Zoom Fellowship in Sept! Eden Church has been presenting Bibles to our church school children when they enter 5th Grade and to our teens when they begin Confirmation classes.

Assemblymember Bill Quirk named Eden United Church of Christ "Nonprofit of the Year" for California Assembly District 20.

A donor-advised fund of the **East Bay Community Foundation** has notified us that they will be investing **\$55,0000** into our **Newcomer Navigation Center!**

Eden Church has been awarded a **\$10,000 COVID-19 Relief Community Grant** from **East Bay Community Energy**. Half will be directed to our food security ministries and half to Eden Area Rent Relief.

Eden Township Health District provided Eden Church with another 2,000 N-95 surgical masks to share with our volunteers and Comida para Cherryland participants.

Chef José Andrés' <u>World Central Kitchen</u>, <u>Restaurants for the People</u>, and <u>Chef's for America</u> in partnership with **Steph Curry**'s <u>Eat Learn Play</u> has chosen Eden Church as a partner for **weekly meal deliveries**. This equates to thousands of dollars in direct food assistance and **isolation support** for the Eden Area.

The <u>Cherryland Computer Café</u> Team exceeded their goals as a contracted Census Assistance Center with Alameda County Census Complete Count Committee. We were able to share information about the census with **more than 4,000 people** since October 2019. Most importantly, our team alone has ensured that Alameda County will receive at least **\$15,000,000** in federal funding for essential services over the next decade, as due to our efforts, more than **1,500** in our census tracts have been counted. **Special thanks to Jonny Victorio** and all who ensure that the Eden Area Counts! **On July 28 were selected by Alameda County Board of Supervisors for a services contract extension, granting the CCC an additional \$35,000.**

The **extension** (until December 31, 2020) on the **Eviction Moratorium** was approved by the Alameda County Board of Supervisors this past Tuesday. Two of our ChYLIs addressed the Board during public comments and advocated for passage of the proposal.

Eden Church has raised and is sharing **\$83,150** (to date) in **rent & utility relief stipends** with residents in Ashland, Cherryland, Fairview, Hayward Acres, and San Lorenzo, through generous gifts from the **East Bay Community Foundation** (\$25,000), **Alameda County First Five** (\$12,500), **Eden Church Members & Friends** (\$15,650), **The San Francisco Foundation** (\$10,000), and **United Way of the Bay Area** (\$5,000). We have also shared \$10,000 in emergency relief funds with Strobridge Elementary School Families through a grant from the **Strobridge Elementary School PTA**. Eden Church has been awarded a **\$50,000** contract to provide essential groceries, diapers and baby wipes, and cleaning supplies for families resident in Unincorporated South Alameda County Housing by the **Alameda County Community Development Department**.

Eden Church has received **\$4,180** in additional remuneration from **United Way of the East Bay** for our Sanctuary and Accompaniment Ministry in 2019.

For the 30 volunteers and the funds raised to provide **over 5,000 meals for Unaccompanied** *Immigrant Youth* with a home cooked supper 6 days per week and a care package for the weekend. Meals were prepared by volunteer chefs in the Oliver Hall Kitchen and transported for pick-up at Tennyson High School HUSD, and for delivery in the Tennyson High School community & delivered to UIY homes in the Cherryland Elementary School community for the past 2 months. This program served as a bridge to invite UIY participation in California's Pandemic EBT program, which provides nutritious food for students without SS#s, for the coming year.
