Sheila Hardy is recovering well from heart transplant surgery performed at Stanford on Sunday, May 30. She came home from the hospital on Jun 11, 2021, has been doing well overall, but was readmitted for a week or so earlier this month.

Congratulations to **John Honerkamp & Jessica Shimmin** on the purchase of their new home in Alameda. They moved their home earlier this month, but are not planning a change of school or church.

Eden's own **Karen Victorio** was recognized by Hayward City Councilmember Francisco Zermeno as his Hayward Youth of the Month for October 2021, in recognition of her significant community service record and her artistic gifts as exemplified in the creation of Eden's COVID-19 Lotoria game. Karen is an animation major at Chico State, the daughter of **Maria del Consuelo Saldate-Victorio Arellano**, and sister of Jonny, Kimberly, Lacy, and Ariadni Victorio.

Team EUCC has, to date, helped **428 Alameda County families** successfully obtain rent relief through the Alameda County Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP), including one of the families in our Accompaniment Ministry, who was profoundly affected by COVID-19, and whose landlord received \$11,000 in rent and utilities relief.

The Alameda County Board of Supervisors has approved a resolution to provide **\$65M in rent relief** for tenants who have been severely impacted economically by the pandemic.
