Comida para Cherryland: Comida para Cherryland now serves the community as a drive-through distribution. Please consider a donation or forward this information to anyone who is looking for a way to help local residents in need of groceries. Since the COVID-19 crisis unfurled, participation in the Comida has expanded geographically and clients served has tripled, due to widespread unemployment and the closure of other area food pantries.

In **The Journey**, author Adam Hamilton travels from Nazareth to Bethlehem in a fascinating look at the birth of Jesus Christ. Sheila Hardy is recovering well from heart transplant surgery performed at Stanford on Sunday, May 30. She came home from the hospital on Jun 11, 2021, and celebrated her 68th birthday this past week.

Eden Crafters' Holiday Auction raised over \$600 for Comida para Cherryland. Thank you to everyone who purchased a handcrafted item and hugs and kisses to our Crafters who generously donated their time, talent, and craft supplies to the auction.

Team EUCC has, to date, helped **600+ Alameda County families** successfully obtain rent relief through the Alameda County Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP), including one of the families in our Accompaniment Ministry, who was profoundly affected by COVID-19, and whose landlord received \$11,000 in rent and utilities relief.

The Alameda County Board of Supervisors has approved a resolution to provide **\$65M in rent relief** for tenants who have been severely impacted economically by the pandemic.

We thank God for **Mel Lim's** 15 years of faithful service to Eden United Church of Christ, as Night Sexton for 13 years, and as a CICT Team Member for the past 2 years. Mel will be retiring on December 15, 2021. We wish him and his family all the best.
