

Pride Activities at the San Lorenzo Library: In the wake of Proud Boys storming a Drag Queen Storytime at the San Lorenzo library in early June, Alameda County D-3 Supervisor Dave Brown has pledged to fund one Pride focused event per month at the San Lorenzo Library from Jul 2022 to Jun 2023.

The Library's Kickoff event will take place on Wed, Jul 27. The day begins with an opening ceremony hosted by Supervisor Brown at which Pastor Arlene has been invited to speak. The Rainbow Families Story Time will follow from 11:30 - 12:30 pm.

Pastor Arlene and her spouse, Stephanie, have been asked to share a bit of their story with the public through a facilitated conversation by the Alameda County Librarian Cindy Chadwick. This Oprah-style event will be held from 6-7 pm, in-person at the library and over livestream.

Comida para Cherryland: Our just-in-time food pantry is currently projecting a \$150K deficit between Apr 1 and Oct 15, due to an unexpected delay in County emergency food services funding. Now serving five times as many people as we did pre-pandemic, the gap in funding is causing considerable belt-tightening in our community.
