

COMMUNITY POTLUCK REUNION TODAY

Whether you are a Church member, a long-time friend, a volunteer with our community programs or a newcomer, you are invited to reunite with us at Meek Park on **Sunday**, **Oct 2 at 11 am to 1 pm**. This is not your standard issue potluck. At least we hope it won't be! We are asking you to participate in making this an extra special community building event by **dressing yourself and your kids in one of the rainbow colors (red, orange, yellow, green, blue, or purple)** and **by bringing a table decoration that represents friendship, love, or community**. (Think either a photo or an object that reminds you of a special time or maybe just flowers in a favorite vase or cup.)

Also, to make this potluck reflect our environmental values by minimizing waste, we are asking each family to bring their own plates and utensils, as well as an entree or side dish to share. For fun and games, we'll be telling stories at the table and playing picnic games. And there will be free ice cream! Our picnic sites (No. 1 & 2) are adjacent to the tot lot. Neighbors In Need Offering: Today, **Sunday, Oct 2,** we invite your participation in the UCC's 2022 Neighbors in Need (NIN) Offering. The NIN Offering goes two-thirds to the UCC's Justice and Witness Ministries to fund a wide array of local and national justice

initiatives, advocacy efforts, and direct service projects and one-third to UCC's Council for American Indian Ministries (CAIM). This year's theme for NIN is Behold! (James 5:4) and the focus is on economic justice, especially fair and just wages. See the bulletin insert for more information and links. Mortgage Relief Workshop: On **Saturday, Oct 22,** from 10 am to noon, Eden Church will co-host a Mortgage Relief Seminar in the sanctuary about the <u>Urban County</u> <u>Mortgage Assistance Program</u>. This event is co-sponsored with ACHCD (Alameda County Housing & Community Development) & HERA (Housing and Economic Rights Advocates.) The event is being offered for Spanish-speaking homeowners who have suffered economic losses due to the pandemic. Similar seminars will be hosted in other languages in accordance with public requests and needs. Help us get the word out to those who may benefit from mortgage relief.

The **FY21 Eden Church single audit** was successfully completed this past week, and filed with the federal government!

The Alameda County Board of Supervisors approved **\$300,000** in **ARPA funding** for Eden Church in July and Sep 2022 to cover economic losses incurred during the pandemic. Three supervisors earmarked \$100K to benefit the Church including: Districts 2 (Supervisor Richard Valle), District 3 (Supervisor Dave Brown), and District 4 (Supervisor Nate Milley). The allocation from D4 was received last month. The allocations from D3 and D4 are scheduled for payment this fall.

Congratulations to our **Eden UCC VAXX Team**, and the whole RCD-LF Coalition who drew 150 attendees for the Summer Celebration on Aug 27. Approximately 20 people received a vaccination. Eighty families received free food boxes and seventy families received gift cards.
