Pastor Marvin's Clergy Renewal Grant Application: Happy news! The Church Council approved Pastor Marvin's Clergy Renewal Plan for a three-month sabbatical for Summer 2024. In anticipation of the sabbatical, Eden Church and Pastor Marvin are preparing a joint application to the Lilly Endowment Clergy Renewal Program.

The Lilly Endowment's 2023 Clergy Renewal Program asks, "What will make your heart sing?" In answer to this question, Pastor Marvin's sabbatical plan centers on the theme **cultivar**, meaning to cultivate, to nourish and nurture in preparation for growth. His program focuses on regenerating, nurturing and growing connections between family and community through language, food, memory, travel, and togetherness.

The Church Council formed a Clergy Renewal Committee (CRC) to work closely with Pastor Marvin on the application. Carlos Londoño (Council) is serving as the Authorized Congregational Representative for the application. Other members of the CRC include Julie Booher (Trustees and Council), Keith Smith (Stewardship and ESLO), and Jessica Shimmin (Eden Area Foundation). The application is due Mar 15, 2023.

Our Time to Shine! Window Replacement Campaign: Last Oct, at the Semi-Annual Meeting, the Congregation unanimously approved the launch of a \$100,000 capital campaign to replace the 73-year old opaque windows in the Sanctuary. Thanks to the leadership we have already collected \$71,700 in pledges and gifts. Additional pledges are needed to reach, and ideally exceed the goal, so that the process of ordering the custom built windows can begin as soon as possible. Pledge forms are included in

JOYS

Our \$100,000 "Our Time to Shine!" Capital Campaign was unanimously approved last Oct. To date, **\$71,700** in pledges have been received.

The Church School children and youth raised over \$150 for the Let It Shine Campaign last Sunday at their pop-up cookie sale.

George Day is home from the hospital recovering from a cardiac procedure.

Eden Church was awarded a \$100,000 Capacity Building Grant from Alameda County Housing and Community Development to help us strengthen core operations of the Church, so that we can sustain and continue to scale up our community service in the Eden Area. This grant includes funding to hire professional consultants (BDO FMA's SF Bay Area Office) to review and recommend updates to our governance documents and policies, and help us onboard an accountant and an operations manager to help us shoulder the workload. Our Church Council met yesterday morning to receive a report and act on recommendations from the Managing Director of BDO FMA.

Franklin Lopez, an asylum-seeker from Colombia, for whom we raised funds for legal aid, just received notice that his I-589 has been lodged, and that he will be eligible for a temporary green card in April 2023. Many thanks to all who contributed prayers and funds!

Between Mar 16, 2021 and Dec 21, 2022, Eden UCC and Padres Unidos de Cherryland's ERAP Teams have processed 2,278 rent relief applications, which has resulted in the awarding of \$22,725,316.34 in rent relief for 1,575 tenants and 1,575 landlords.
