

EUCC Lilly Endowment Recipient: Friends, it is a great pleasure to announce that Eden UCC was awarded a \$60,000 grant from the Lilly Endowment's National Clergy Renewal Program in partnership with Christian Theological Seminary. This grant will support Pastor Marvin and our congregation in a three-month process of cultivating joy through cultural expressions that include art, food, coffee, and language.

Selection as a National Clergy Renewal Program award recipient is the result of months of hard work. Over the winter, Pastor Marvin and Moderator Carlos Londoño wrote and revised multiple application drafts, with input from Church Council and the Clergy Renewal Committee that included Julie Booher (Trustee and Council), Keith Smith (ESLO & Stewardship), and Jessica Shimmin (Eden

Area Foundation Grants Chair). In February, the congregation offered suggestions through a survey. And in March, the Church Council approved and submitted the final application.

Congratulations to all of us! The grant will support Pastor Marvin and his family in renewing connections between family and community through language, food, memory, travel, and togetherness during the summer of 2024.

It's Time to Get "Boo-sted": The CDC, CDPH, and ACPHD recommend that all persons 6 months and older receive the newly updated COVID-19 vaccine, just authorized last month. This new monovalent vaccine targets the more recent dominant circulating strains of Omicron, and will help boost our immunity that

attenuates with time. If it has been more than two months since you received the previous (last year's bivalent or any previous) COVID-19 vaccine, you are eligible now.
