Advent can be filled with worry about finding the perfect Christmas gifts. Deep down we want people in our lives to know they are special and that we love them. But sometimes we overlook the greatest gift of all... our very <u>presence</u>. Our new worship series, "The Gift of Being Present," celebrates the idea that the best gift God ever gave us was the presence of the Divine in the person of Jesus... and that the best gift we can give the world is our presence in the places and to the people who need it most.
