**24/7 Crisis Text Line:** <u>Crisis Support Services of Alameda County</u> (CSS) is pleased to announce that their crisis text line is now available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Similar to a crisis hotline, this text line offers crisis intervention for people—especially youth—who prefer texting to talking on the phone. People of all ages who are struggling with difficult life circumstances or uncomfortable thoughts and emotions can text the word SAFE to 20121 to start a session, and will receive a message from a trained counselor within a few minutes. CSS offers a broad range of counseling, education and prevention services in a safe environment. Services include on-going therapy groups, school-based counseling, supportive services for seniors, suicide prevention for youth; and community education.

*It's Time to Stay Protected*: The CDC, CDPH, and ACPHD recommend that all persons 6 months and older receive the newly updated COVID-19 vaccine, just authorized last month. This new monovalent vaccine targets the more recent dominant circulating strains of Omicron, and will help boost our immunity that attenuates with time. If it has been more than two months since you received the previous (last year's bivalent or any previous) COVID-19 vaccine, you are eligible now.
