

24/7 Crisis Text Line: Crisis Support Services of Alameda County (CSS) is pleased to announce that their crisis text line is now available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Similar to a crisis hotline, this text line offers crisis intervention for people—especially youth—who prefer texting to talking on the phone. People of all ages who are struggling with difficult life circumstances or uncomfortable thoughts and emotions can text the word SAFE to 20121 to start a session, and will receive a message from a trained counselor within a few minutes. CSS offers a broad range of counseling, education and prevention services in a safe environment. Services include on-going therapy groups, school-based counseling, supportive services for seniors, suicide prevention for youth; and community education.


