Annual Meeting: TODAY, immediately following worship in the sanctuary, Eden Church will hold its 159th Annual Congregational Meeting. The meeting will be hybrid, held in person in the sanctuary, and virtually on Zoom. Remote attendees who registered in advance were sent a private digital meeting link. Regrettably, we don't have the capacity to manage last minute registrations. Meeting agenda items include the election of lay leaders, approving a budget for the coming fiscal year, and action on proposed updated bylaws.

Visitors are welcome. Members are eligible to vote. A quorum of members present is required for the meeting to take place.
