**Join Us on the Way to Bethlehem:** As **Advent continues**, we turn our attention to this season of preparation as we await again the birth of the Christ into the world. Advent is often a time when many of us travel, and we are so often focused on the destination in our travels. But what if it is the journey itself that offers the most memorable moments, both frustrating and delightful? This Advent season, we will pay attention not just to the destination of Christmas, but also to the places where events occurred that led to a starry night on which a child was born who would change the world. Throughout this season, we will visit different places that shaped the path of Jesus' birth narrative: Rome, Jerusalem, Nazareth, Bethlehem, and the Manger. Places shape us and shape our stories, even if we simply journey to and through them for a little while. We are changed as their narratives become part of ours. By focusing on the places that shaped Jesus, we learn more about why his life, ministry, and death became one of the most significant narratives of human history. Join Eden Church as we celebrate this journey through Advent! Throughout the Advent season, we encourage you to reflect on the Advent journey. **Reflection journals for this purpose are available in the sanctuary.**

**Changes Coming For Worship Communications:** The worship team is making some adjustments to our worship communication and media. Please be aware of the following changes coming:

- *Beginning Dec 1*, we will no longer send out Saturday worship links or Sunday-afternoon video/sermon links. The worship links will be incorporated into the eChimes every week, and post-worship resources will always be available on the online worship page of the Eden UCC website. Prepare to start saving your eChimes through the weekend to easily access the links.
- *Beginning Sun, Jan 5, 2025*, we will no longer be printing a bulletin, and will instead transition to using the "Services" function in Church Center. Worship attendees will be able to access the order of worship through the **Church Center app** on a cell phone or tablet, along with a link to announcements, weekly programs, and the prayer list of joys and concerns. QR codes posted in the back of the sanctuary and in the pew pockets will provide quick links to the documents.
- A few LARGE PRINT paper copies of the order of worship will be printed for those who prefer this media format. As we get closer to "going paperless," the pastors will be available after worship during coffee hour to assist worshippers to connect to the Church Center app.
