# **European TRWP Platform Meeting**

#### Context:

In response to the current debate on microplastics from tyre and road wear, the European TRWP Platform was launched in July 2018 to address with relevant stakeholders how to prevent and mitigate the generation and transportation of tyre and road wear particles (TRWP) in the environment.

After the conclusion of the first year, all participants - spanning from governments, academia, civil society organisations and industries - acknowledged the value of this multistakeholder exchange and agreed upon the necessity to renew the mandate of the Platform in order to continue the open and inclusive dialogue on TRWP and further explore the implementation of the potential mitigation measures identified by the Platform in the 'Way Forward Report'.

This meeting aims at providing an update on recent scientific studies on TRWP.
