And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." *Matthew 28:18-20*

VISION AND MISSION

Have you ever been gripped by the love of Jesus? If no, we hope that through these pages, you will experience the depths that Jesus went to win your heart. If yes, imagine what your life would be like today if Jesus's love, joy, peace, and patience were not an everlasting reality in your life. Where would you be? What would the desperation in your heart feel like?

This is the reality of 3.14 billion people who don't know Jesus. We cannot let this be.
This is the reality that together we are going to change.

But before we do this, there is a good chance you are wondering, "What or who is All Nations?"

In All Nations, we are a people captivated by the love of Jesus. We are broken-hearted that billions of people have never experienced His love. And we are surrendered to His purpose of bringing the truth of Jesus to every people group on earth.

All Nations was founded by Floyd and Sally McClung in 1993 with **OUR VISION** to see Jesus worshipped by all the people groups of the earth! We believe that when people truly worship Jesus, amazing things happen. Communities are transformed. Justice reigns. The sick are healed. The brokenhearted are comforted. The oppressed are freed and the weak are strengthened.

We believe the most effective way to see this happen is through **OUR MISSION** to make disciples and train leaders to ignite church-planting movements among the neglected peoples of the earth. We want to empower the least, the last, and the lost to passionately follow Jesus. We don't just want to reach them. We want to see Jesus make them into leaders and launch them into their destinies.

There is much work to be done. We cannot do it alone. We need the Holy Spirit, Jesus and the Father by our side and in our hearts. And we need each other. But take heart, God is more than enough, and He has created and prepared us for this task in advance (*Eph. 2:10*).

And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come. *Matthew 24:14*

...there before me was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, tribe, people and language, standing before the throne and before the Lamb... *Revelation 7:9*



How to? On the Ground

How do we reach these unreached people groups? How do we make disciples and raise up leaders? How do we ignite church-planting movements? What does it look like on the ground? Those are great questions!

What we are about to tell you may sound too simple. That is intentional. Simple is reproducible. When things can be reproduced simply and quickly, movements can begin. Anyone can be a part of a large movement of people to Jesus. Yet, movements are not easy. Whether you are going, sending, or mobilizing, making disciples will require your whole being and will be some of the hardest days of your life. But, the rewards are immeasurable.

Definitions

Before we get to the how, let's define some terms. You may notice the similarity and simplicity of these key terms:

- A disciple is someone attempting to live in loving obedience to Jesus and His commands.
 - A church is a spiritual community attempting to live in loving obedience to Jesus and His commands.
 - A church-planting movement (CPM) is a group of spiritual communities who are multiplying, resulting in other spiritual communities attempting to live in loving obedience to Jesus and His commands. Four generations or more of this multiplication denotes a movement.
- In All Nations, we use the term disciple-making movement (DMM) interchangeably with CPM as we train disciples to make disciples and churches to plant churches!

5 Phases of Church-Planting Movements



1. **Pray** - Pray until you can weep over people. Fast and pray. Walk and pray. Ask God to let you see what He sees and feel what He feels. Pray for a man or woman of peace. Pray for the Lord to give you specific strategies.
2. **Meet** - Meet people where they are. Hang out with those who don't know Jesus. Look for pockets of people that have no Jesus followers in them. When you meet people go and meet their friends.
3. **Make Disciples** - Invest in people's lives and build meaningful relationships. Don't wait for them to pray to accept Jesus. Disciple-making is about introducing people to Jesus in such a way that they get to know Him personally, and then learn to love and obey Him.
4. **Gather** - Allow those you meet who are spiritually open to gather with other seekers for fun, meals, prayer, and studying God's Word. Focus on the words and stories of Jesus. Gathering people together is the beginning of planting a church.
5. **Multiply** (Plan for Growth) - From the beginning, train new believers to take responsibility for meetings and outreaches. Stay in the background as much as possible to encourage others to grow and exercise their spiritual gifts. When you get too big to live out the "one another" of Scripture, make a plan to multiply and start a new gathering.



2 Timothy 2:2

SEVEN GENERAL COMMANDS OF CHRIST

Luke 10

Before we can plant a church, we need to make disciples. Making disciples is always our first priority.

We have found that many of Jesus' commands can be summed up in the seven basic commands of Jesus:

- Repent, Believe, and Receive the Holy Spirit (Mark 1:15, Acts 2:37-41, Acts 26:20)
- Be Baptized (Matthew 3:13-17, Acts 8:26-39, Romans 6:3-8)
- Break Bread and Fellowship (Luke 22:14-24, 1 Corinthians 11:17-34, Hebrews 10:24-25)
- Love
 - a. God (Deuteronomy 6:1-8, Matthew 22:32-40, Mark 14:3-9)
 - b. Other Believers (John 13:1-17, 31-35, Acts 2:42-47, 1 John 3:11-24)
 - c. Your Neighbor (Matthew 22:36-40, Luke 10:25-37, Mark 2:1-12)
 - d. Your Enemy (Matthew 5:43-47, Luke 23:32-43, Romans 5:6-11)
- Pray (Matthew 6:5-15, Luke 18:1-14, John 14:12-14).
- Give (2 Corinthians 9:6-15, Mark 12:41-44, Matthew 6:1-4, Matthew 25:31-46)
- Go and Make Disciples (Matthew 28:18-20, Luke 10:1-16, Mark 5:1-20)

The discipleship process is discovery-based, often done through stories, and places a high value on obedience rather than focusing on merely the transfer of knowledge. We want to help people to discover truth, not force it on them. As people learn Jesus stories, they can more easily pass on the good news to others. The focus on obedience ensures we reproduce doers of the word and not simply hearers. Faith without works is dead. We abide in His life by obeying His commands (James 1:22; 2:17, John 15:9-11).



HUB AND SPOKES MODEL

How do we find the workers? How do we train them? How do we send them? What do we do once they are on the field? All of those are great questions! All Nations operates in what we call a hub-and-spokes model. Hubs are catalytic centers located in regional gateway cities of the world to mobilize, train, send, coach, and care for our missionaries on the field.

We currently have four hubs:

- Kansas City, United States
- Cape Town, South Africa
- Kampala, Uganda
- Hamburg, Germany

We plan to launch 10 hubs by 2030 in strategic gateway cities to mobilize cross-cultural and near-culture workers from everywhere to everywhere until every people group is reached.

While the hubs are partnering with local churches to train, mobilize, send, and care for workers, All Nations International supports the hubs in these efforts and is working to launch new hubs around the world.



STRATEGIC PRIORITIES

We are continually seeking Jesus for initiatives that we need to focus on. We call them strategic priorities which have varying lifespans depending on their focus. Currently, All Nations has eight strategic priorities:

- Cultivate Abundant Prayer and Worship
- Develop Leaders
- Train and Coach Disciple-Makers
- Mobilize for Priority Unreached People Groups
- Mobilize Muslim Background Believers
- Disciple Children to be Disciple-Makers
- Activate Business for Movements
- Ignite Urban Church Planting Movements

All Nations' Priority People Groups – Our Piece

Will All Nations reach every people group on earth? We are going to try to reach as many of them as we can but are excited that we are not alone. We get to partner with amazing people, churches, organizations, and networks all around the world. Currently, All Nations works in 44 different countries and has prioritized the 12 unengaged and unreached people groups listed below.

All Nations regularly asks, "What is our part in finishing the Great Commission?" As we feel the Lord putting certain people groups on our hearts, we add them to our list of adopted peoples. We focus our prayers on those people, raise awareness of the groups, mobilize workers and resources, send teams to reach them, and eventually help these formerly unreached peoples reach other unreached peoples!

As we engage the groups on the list, we pray and add new groups. It does not mean that we only send workers to those groups. Our part in finishing the Great Commission is being a conduit for others to make disciples and raise up leaders in ALL the neglected people groups.

Trainings

A large part of All Nations is training and equipping the body of Christ to be Jesus' hands and feet here on earth. We inspire and empower passionate followers of Jesus. Below are a few of the trainings that we offer globally. Please visit each of our hub's websites* to see all of the trainings offered.

- a. **Church Planting Experience (CPx)** – This 3-week training will equip believers with practical tools to be a long-term cross-cultural church planter. You will learn how to share Jesus with people from many different cultures and empower local believers to positions of leadership in churches. You will learn how to be a life-long learner who listens to the guiding of the Holy Spirit.
- b. **Storytelling** - Learn to tell stories like Jesus did! In this interactive training, you will practice telling Jesus stories naturally, enthusiastically, and with love. Stories invite and lead people to a life-altering relationship with Jesus.
- c. **Senders U** - Senders have the same high and lofty calling in seeing the Great Commission accomplished. Paul says in Romans 10:15, "And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent?" Senders U explores the art of sending well and the indispensable role of senders in taking the good news to the last remaining unengaged people groups.
- d. **Discipleship Bootcamp** - All Nations' Discipleship Bootcamp is an intensive training to equip God's people to make and multiply disciples in a way that is simple and reproducible. Using Jesus as our model, we will walk through the value of discipleship and answer questions like: Who is a disciple? What does a disciple do? Why is discipleship so important?
- e. **Business 4 Movement (B4M)** - Do you want to learn how to launch a disciple-making business? This 5-day training equips church planters to start sustainable businesses in a church-planting movement.



WHAT DOES IT TAKE?

In order to reach every people group on earth, it is going to take all of us giving our lives to see Jesus worshipped. This means it will take all of us giving Jesus our time, talents and finances. People will need to go. People will need to send. People will need to give. People will need to train. People will need to care for those who have gone and those whom they have left. What is your part in reaching all nations?


