- **Language:** Kangean (Others: Madurese & Indonesian)
- **Main Religion:** Islam

Indonesia's cluster of Kangean Islands is located in the Java Sea, just east of Madura and north of Bali. Kangean families there suffer greatly from economic and educational deficiencies. Many must move to other islands to seek employment and/or to continue studies beyond middle school. Almost all produce is supplied by outside sources. Their schools are also aggressively influenced by Islamic thinking from India. In addition, the Kangeans remain one of the most unreached people groups in Central Indonesia. Although friendly, they are a fearful people, suspicious of outsiders, especially foreigners. Their practice of Islam is mixed with animistic beliefs and rituals to appease spirits.

All Nations' fieldworkers, the Frank* family, have lived in Bali for nearly six years. In addition to discipling local believers, they have been praying specifically for the Kangeans. In June 2019, the Franks* took their first scouting trip to the Kangean Islands where their team prayed onsite and gathered logistical information. They also established contact with Jon*, an Indonesian believer from another island, who lives among the Kangeans and has a heart for sharing the Gospel with them. The Franks*' vision is to capture God's heart for the Kangeans and to become His hands, feet, and voice to this neglected people group.

PRAYER POINTS

- Breakthroughs with the Gospel among the Kangeans
- Blessings upon the Franks* relationship with Jon*, who has access to the islands via employment
- Jon*, as he struggles with loneliness and with difficulties logistically and relationally
- The opening of a new airport, which would make the Islands more accessible for tourist and for business opportunities
- Wisdom logistically for the Franks* with future visits, as it is a very difficult two-day trip, weather permitting. Their last visit was over a year ago.
- Local disciples of the Franks* to grow in their love for Jesus
- Blessings upon mentoring relationships between some key leaders in their group
- Discipleship movements marked by prayer and the presence of Jesus
- The manifestation of the Kingdom through miracles, signs and wonders
- Persons of peace to open doors for the Gospel to enter families, communities, or even regions
- Health and blessings upon the Frank* family, for their daughter to stay focused and diligent with her last years of school, and for their son to have safe travels and financial provision while living in the USA
