- Total Population of Senegal: over 16 million
- Fulani Population in Senegal: 3.5 million
- Language(s): Pulaar (main)
French & Arabic (secondary)
- Main Religion: Islam



OVERVIEW

In Senegal, the Fulani people are the second most populous group. Most are non literate and live in rural areas raising livestock, farming and fishing. However, there is a growing number of youth moving to cities for employment. In villages, people suffer from malaria and other infectious diseases. Though 98% consider themselves Muslims, their practices are mixed in superstitions, myths, rituals and other native beliefs. Many still remain unreached with the gospel.

All Nations' field worker Dani* lives in Denville where her passion is to help the Fulani people come to know Jesus and to plant basic churches among the Fulani people. Her discipleship and evangelism are primarily through one-on-one relationships and small house gatherings.
