OVERVIEW



The coastal city of Malmö, Sweden, located in the southwestern part of the country, is diverse with one in every three people in the city being foreign-born. Many of these foreigners are Muslim refugees who have fled their home countries, including: Iraq, Syria, Bosnia, Somalia and Afghanistan. They long for a better life for themselves and their children. Many come from traumatic situations or from places where the Gospel has not yet reached.

Moreover, the refugees face many challenges in Sweden, including assimilation into the new culture, language learning, and job acquisition. Most come to this developed city from countries with different levels of education, so their training or experience is not enough or goes unrecognized. In addition, their sense of belonging suffers amid Sweden's nominal Christianity and private nature.

Currently, the All Nations' team in Malmö is committed to joining God in what He is doing among the Muslim refugees there. One couple, fluent in Arabic, is engaged in research among Afghan refugee minors, as well as discipling and building relational bridges, especially between Arabs and Christians in the city. The newer couple is focused on intercession and language learning, while working vocationally and adjusting to life as a growing family.

For the refugees in Sweden, please pray for...

- · God to work in their hearts.
- Provision of jobs, education, language and basic necessities for establishment, including citizenship.
- Healing from trauma incurred by leaving family and painful situations in their home countries, as well as from the culture shock of a new place.
- More Christians to begin befriending this group.
