ReCap ASáp: regaining capacity in a changing Sápmi

The Interreg Aurora project **ReCap ASáp: Regaining capacity in a changing Sápmi**kicked off in September 2023, and the first
months have been spent preparing for the rest
of the project period.

At the end of October 2023, the project team met in Roavvenjárga. Here, communications and the Boahtteáiggi jurdagat toolkit were on the agenda. The development and adaptation of the toolkit to a Sámi context will be of help for future strategic thinking in Sápmi.

The Saami Council staff have been able to test out some of the Boahtteáiggi jurdagat methods, and they will be further tested out by the Knowledge Hubs.
