# What is a CSA?

CSA stands for Community Supported Agriculture. A CSA is a relationship between our farm and you as our supporter. Our customers become "members" of our farm and receive a portion of our farm's harvest for the season. CSA's help support small scale farmers.



## Growing Season & Share

Our season runs from the end of June/early July until mid-October. At the beginning of each week, we will share with our supporters what they can expect in each share for the week.

Supporters can also choose to add on additional items to their shares each week for additional costs. Add-ons include items from our Kiss the Dirt product line, teas, flowers, and eggs from Three Brothers Farm.

## Pick Up & Delivery

Members can pick up their share on Sundays at the Riverwest Farmers Market or Thursdays from our home in West Milwaukee. We may add an additional market day pick up as well.

We also offer delivery within 15 miles of our farm plot in Mequon for an additional \$50 delivery fee. Delivery date will be on Thursdays.



## Costs

Full Share: (4-6 people)

- \$500
- Non-refundable deposit of \$250 to reserve your spot

Half Share (2-3 people)

- \$350
- Non-refundable deposit of \$175 to reserve your spot

Egg Share

- \$80 per share (one dozen eggs each week of CSA)
- Non-refundable payment due upfront

Delivery

- \$50 for the season
- Delivery fees will be charged in June to give members time to discern their pick up options

\*We promise to do our best to provide you with a beautiful, bountiful share each week. The quantity of produce may vary from week-to-week depending on extreme weather, pests/insects or other production factors. By joining our CSA, you are agreeing to share the risk of crop failure with us and other members. **All shares are non-refundable.** In the event of crop failure, we will do our best to fill your bags with other crops grown on our farm or with assistance from other area farms.
