Welcome to the eighth (we can hardly believe it!) annual Great Salt Lake Fringe Festival at The Gateway! As always, we have an incredible line-up of performing artists this year, and we hope you enjoy experiencing a variety of innovative theatre while exploring all the dining, shopping, and entertainment that The Gateway has to offer.

If you're new to Fringe, or just need a refresher, here's how it works: Over two weekends, dozens of performing arts companies perform original, cutting-edge work in our pop-up venues. Everything is under an hour. Shows are uncensored, self-rated, and unadjudicated. Explore the program, buy tickets online or at our box office, and get your Fringe on!

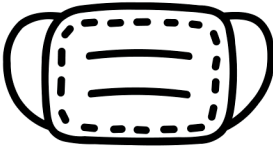
Our box office is located inside the Urban Arts Gallery at 116 S Rio Grande St, and opens one hour before shows start each day.

This year's Fringe venues are located on both ends of the Gateway, and all of the venues are about a 5-minute walk from the box office. We highly recommend skipping the box office and buying tickets online to guarantee seats! Fringe venues are small and shows often sell out or go to standing room only.

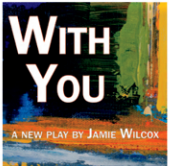
