🌸 THIS YEAR'S TALENT

KALIA KLIBAN has been an integral part of the vibrant California Bay Area traditional dance community since the mid-80s. She performs, dances, and teaches morris, longsword, English and American clogging, English country dance, and contra. Known for a relaxed, welcoming calling style and clear and concise teaching, she is in demand at dance events across the US.

SHIRA KAMMEN is a California based but internationally known multi-instrumentalist. She has spent well over half her life exploring early music and other intriguing styles and has been a member of countless early music groups, English Country and Balkan bands, Shakespeare Festival orchestras and is the founder of Class V Music, an ensemble dedicated to providing music on river rafting trips.

KAREN AXELROD left the world of classical music over 25 years ago and has found her home in the folk world. She is highly regarded for her creative piano playing at English, American and Scottish dance events around the globe. Her improvisational playing is both lyrical but touched with humor and whimsy. Karen is a member of the bands Foxfire and Alchemy.

Fiddler and violist, ERIC MARTIN brings soulful expression to many folkdance idioms. Eric holds performance degrees from Ithaca College and University of Limerick, Ireland. That classical foundation, coupled with the freedom inherent in traditional music, makes him a favorite at English country dances, contras, balls, camps, and concerts across North America. His bands include Alchemy, Axelrod-Martin duo and Coincidence. He lives and works at Gould Farm, a therapeutic farming community, in the Berkshires of Massachusetts.
