TERMS

One Valley Community Foundation will accept "offline" donations as part of Give Big, and will manually process them through the Give Big platform, provided that participating organizations and their donors follow these policies:

- This form must accompany all offline donations.
- Checks mailed to One Valley must be postmarked on or before Monday, April 29th.
- Checks and cash dropped off at the offices of One Valley Community Foundation must be received by 4:00 pm on Friday, May 3rd.
- If utilizing an IRA or donor-advised fund distribution, the check request should be made to the appropriate institution no later than Friday, April 19th, as most institutions take up to 2 weeks to approve distributions.
- Donors will receive tax acknowledgments from One Valley Community Foundation for their offline gifts, unless the gifts come from an already tax-privileged account (e.g. a donor-advised fund). No other receipts will be provided on the day of Give Big.
- Offline gifts will appear on each nonprofit organization's Give Big page and on the Give Big leaderboard between 6:00 pm on Thursday, May 2nd and 6:00 pm on Friday, May 3rd.
- Offline Gifts will not be eligible for prizes.
