

# Ways to Give

- \$5 minimum donation
- Donate online at GiveBigGV.org (April 30<sup>th</sup> May 6<sup>th</sup>)
  - Credit Card
  - 2. ACH over \$100
  - 3. Mobile Pay Google Pay, Apple Pay
- Give via check
  - Directly to a nonprofit
  - Through One Valley Community Foundation
- Give via stocks, DAFs and IRAs
  - Through One Valley (use Offline Donation Form)

## **Fees**

- Donors are automatically opted-in to covering fees
- Donors covered 82% of the fees in 2024
- Donation Realization Rate: 91%
  - How much each organization "took home"

#### **Credit Card / Mobile Pay**

- 2.5% Platform Fee (GiveGab)
- 2.5% Credit Card Fee + \$0.30
- 3% Host Fee (One Valley)

#### **ACH**

- 2% Platform Fee (GiveGab)
- \$3.00 Processing Fee
- 3% Host Fee (One Valley)

#### **Checks/ Stocks/ IRAs/ DAFs**

- No fees from One Valley or GiveGab
- Donor pays fees for transferring stock

### **Host Fee**



#### What's Changing

- 3% host fee added to online donations only
- Fee goes to One Valley to support Give Big operations
- No host fee on offline gifts (checks, DAFs, etc.)

#### Why It Matters

- Give Big runs at a significant deficit each year, with One Valley covering the costs
- Fee supports staffing, tech, marketing, and prizes
- Ensures long-term sustainability of the initiative

#### For Donors

- Fees shown clearly at checkout
- Donors can choose to cover the fees
- No Tip the Host this year

## **Donating Via Check**

#### **Made Directly to Your Nonprofit**

- Donors write the check out to the nonprofit their donation is intended for
- You can collect these checks leading up to Give Big
- Checks must
  - Be intended for Give Big!
    - Have donors date the checks May 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> and/or have them write "Give Big" in the memo line
  - Be uploaded to your GiveGab profile before 11:59 pm on May 6<sup>th</sup>
- Offline gifts do not count toward prizes



Receipting offline donors:

- Have their email address?
  - Enter it on the form and check the box that says "Email a receipt to"
- Don't have an email address?
  - Receipt them as your organization normally does



# **Donating Via Check**

#### **Through One Valley Community Foundation**

- Why One Valley?
  - Donors can give to multiple organizations with one check
  - Donors want to give anonymously
- Checks must be
  - Mailed by April 25<sup>th</sup> or dropped off by May 2<sup>nd</sup> (One Valley offices 865 Technology Blvd)
  - Accompanied by an Offline Donation Form (coming soon on the <u>Ways to Give page</u>)
  - Intended for Give Big
- Donors are receipted by One Valley

### Donating Via Stocks, IRAs, DAFs

- Transfer of stocks, IRAs, DAFs
  - Accompanied by an Offline Donation Form (coming soon on the Ways to Give Page)
  - Sent to One Valley as soon as possible
    - Latest, April 17<sup>th</sup>
- Donors are receipted by One Valley


## **Matches and Challenges**

Give BIG

- Gifts are made directly to your organization
- Gifts are receipted by your organization
- Checks can be matches, challenges OR offline gifts
  - Do not enter it as more than one of those
- Matches and challenge gifts can be:
  - Made ahead of time (easy if they are giving the full amount either way)
  - OR donated after the event (better if it is a true match)






#### Reset Profile

Resetting the profile will reset the story, thank you message, images, and settings to default values, as well as remove any donation levels. After resetting this profile, a profile from a previous giving day can be copied to use as a standard point.



### Peer-to-Peer Fundraisers

- Opportunity for others to fundraise on your behalf
- More information on P2P fundraisers
  - You can register fundraisers
  - They can register themselves



### **Prizes**

- \$30,000 in prizes, 50 prizes total
- Each nonprofit can only win a large prize (\$500 or more) one time
- Prize list and rules available at <u>GiveBigGV.org/prizes</u>
- Offline donations do not count towards prizes
- Prizes will be confirmed or corrected by May 9<sup>th</sup>
- Prizes that require action ahead of time
  - Equity as a Lived Value
  - Good Neighbor
  - Gallatin Gratitude




#### We Need Your Help

# **Goal Setting**



- Set a goal that feels like a good fit for your organization

Average	\$11,235.35	\$2,568.93	\$2,763.31	\$10,270.36	\$24,844.10
Median	\$3,565.00	\$1,360.00	\$1,675.00	\$6,137.82	\$10,243.71

- Things to consider:
  - Matches, Challenges & Peer-to-Peer Fundraisers
    - Last year, orgs with matches/challenges raised 7x more than orgs without
    - Last year, P2P fundraisers raised an average of \$652
  - Existing donor relationships
  - Team capacity

### **Donor Stewardship**

- Minimal level: Enter message into automated receipt (for those with email address) or send paper receipt (for those without email addresses)
  - Donor privacy options
- Optional stewardship
  - Thank you letter
  - Add donor to database
  - Keep in touch with them

  - May 2nd Reminder to those who haven't given yet




