Mosaic in Action welcomed our seventh and eighth AmeriCorps NCCC teams in 2021– *Sky 6* and *Sun 3*. These two teams put in a combined total of **6,960 volunteer hours** towards our mission during their time with us.

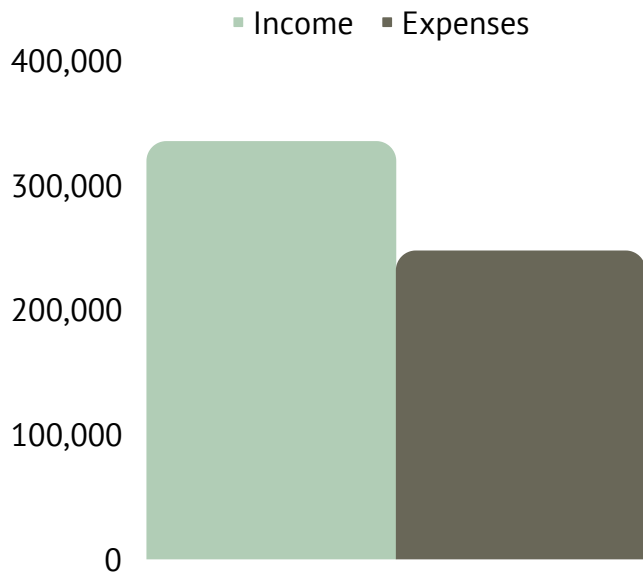
Sky 6 served with MiA from April through July of 2021. This crew showed incredible spirit and determination throughout their term with us even when working on roof repairs in 100° Texas heat. *Sky 6* quickly became family to the MiA staff

and truly left their mark on the Brazoria County community they served.

The arrival of *Sun 3* in early November was highly anticipated, but the excitement was cut short. The team of 12 was called to serve Afghan refugees in Virginia after spending two weeks training with MiA. While we were sad to see them go, we've been so proud to hear about the amazing work they did during their time at the base.

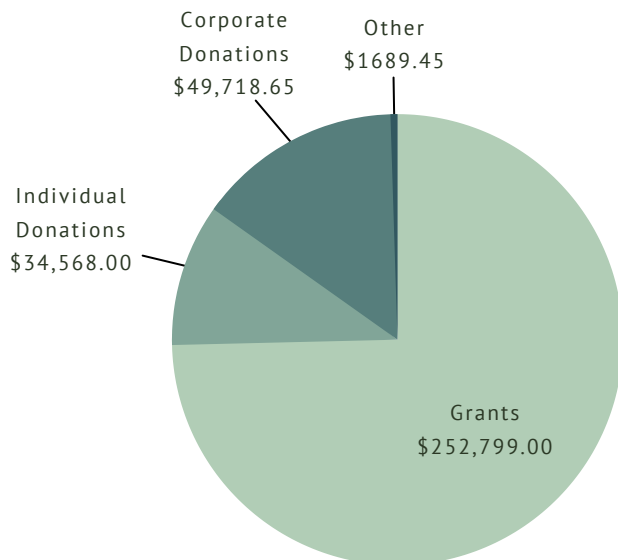
FINANCIAL REPORT



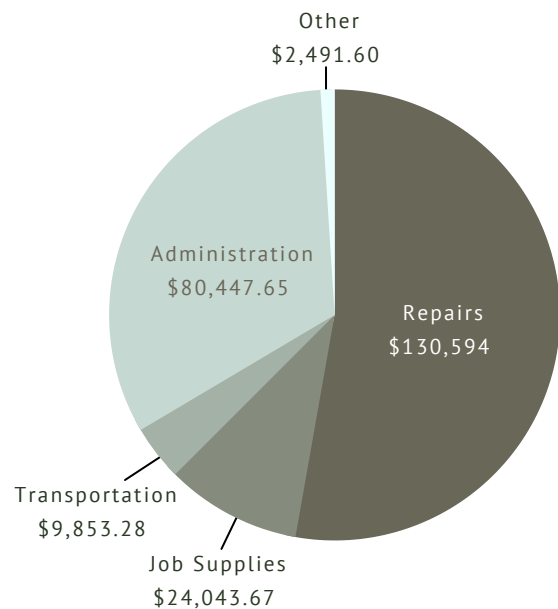
