

Note: The 4-Lakes Loop includes First, Blue Gentian, Lost and West lakes. This plant list contains many of the plants shown on the Blue Gentian Lake Plant List and adds new species, including several mosses, liverworts, fungi, and lichens.

*Coptis trifolia* (Three-leaved goldthread). Ranunculaceae.  
*Dactylis glomerata* (Orchard grass). Poaceae. Introduced  
from Eurasia.  
*Drosera rotundifolia* (Round-leaved sundew). Droseraceae.  
*Eleocharis palustris* (Creeping spike-rush). Cyperaceae.  
*Elliottia* (= *Cladothamnus*) *pyroliflorus* (Copperbush).  
Ericaceae.  
*Elymus glaucus* (Blue wildrye). Poaceae.  
*Erigeron peregrinus* (Subalpine daisy) or *E. speciosus* (Showy  
fleabane). Asteraceae.  
*Eriophorum angustifolium* (Narrow-leaved cotton-grass).  
Cyperaceae (Sedges).  
*Fragaria virginiana* (Wild strawberry). Rosaceae.  
*Gaultheria ovatifolia* (Western teaberry; Oregon  
wintergreen). Ericaceae.

*Gentiana sceptrum* (King or blue gentian).  
*Gentianaceae*. Associated with *Carex canescens* & *C. lenticularis*.

*Glyceria elata* (Tall mannagrass). *Poaceae*.

*Gymnocarpium dryopteris* (Oak fern).  
*Dryopteridaceae* (Wood ferns)

*Hieracium albiflorum* (white-flowered hawkweed). *Asteraceae*.

*Hieracium aurantiacum* (Orange hawkweed or devil's paintbrush). *Asteraceae*. Introduced from Europe.

*Juncus articulatus* (Jointed rush). *Juncaceae*.

*Juncus bufonius* (Toad rush). *Juncaceae*. Includes both native & introduced races.

*Juncus ensifolius* (Dagger-leaved rush). *Juncaceae*.

*Juncus filiformis* (Thread rush). *Juncaceae*.

*Kalmia microphylla* (Western bog-laurel; swamp-laurel). *Ericaceae*.

*Ledum groenlandicum* (Labrador tea). *Ericaceae*.

*Leptarrhena pyrolifolia* (Leatherleaf saxifrage). *Saxifragaceae*.

*Leucanthemum vulgare* (Oxeye daisy). *Asteraceae*. Introduced from Europe.

*Linnaea borealis* (Twinflower). *Caprifoliaceae*.

*Listera caurina* (Northwestern twayblade). *Orchidaceae*.

*Lotus corniculatus* (Birds-foot trefoil). *Fabaceae*. Introduced.

*Lupinus polyphyllus* (Larged-leaved lupine). *Fabaceae*.

*Lycopodium complanatum* (Ground cedar). *Lycopodiaceae*.

*Lycopodium sitchense* (Alaska or Sitka clubmoss). *Lycopodiaceae*.

*Maianthemum dilatatum* (False lily of the valley). *Ruscaceae* (formerly *Liliaceae*)

*Menyanthes trifoliata* (Buckbean; bogbean). *Menyanthaceae*.

*Nuphar polysepala* (Yellow pond lily). *Nymphaeaceae*

*Osmorhiza purpurea* (Purple sweet-cicely). *Apiaceae* (Carrot family).

*Phalaris arundinacea* (Reed canary grass). *Poaceae*.

*Phleum pratense* (Timothy). *Poaceae*.

*Phylodoce empetriformis* (Pink mountain heather). *Ericaceae*.

*Pinus monticola* (Western white pine). *Pinaceae*. Sapling infected with white pine blister rust (*Cronartium ribicola*).

*Platanthera stricta* (Slender bog orchid; slender rein orchid). *Orchidaceae*.

*Prenanthes alata* (Western rattlesnake root). *Asteraceae*.

*Pyrola* (= *Orthilia*) *secunda* (One-sided wintergreen). *Ericaceae*.

*Ranunculus acris* (Tall or meadow buttercup). *Ranunculaceae*.

*Rhododendron albiflorum* (White-flowered rhododendron). *Ericaceae*.

*Rubus pedatus* (Five-leaved bramble). *Rosaceae*.

*Rumex obtusifolius* (Bitter or broad-leaved dock). *Polygonaceae*.

*Scirpus cespitosus* (= *Trichophorum cespitosum*) (Tufted club rush). *Cyperaceae*.

*Solidago Canadensis* (Canada goldenrod). *Asteraceae*.

*Sonchus arvensis* (Perennial snow thistle). *Asteraceae*.

*Sorbus sitchensis* (Sitka mountain ash). *Rosaceae*.

*Sparganium angustifolium* (Narrow-leaved bur-reed). *Sparganiaceae* (related to *Typhaceae*, the cattails)

*Spergularia rubra* (Red sand spurry). *Caryophyllaceae* (pinks). Introduced.

*Spiraea densiflora* (Subalpine spiraea; mountain spiraea) *Rosaceae*.

*Spiranthes romanzoffiana* (Ladies' tresses). *Orchidaceae*.

*Tiarella trifoliata* var. *unifoliata* (Foamflower). *Saxifragaceae*.

*Tiarella trifoliata* var. *trifoliata* (Foamflower). *Saxifragaceae*.

*Tofieldia glutinosa* (Sticky false asphodel). *Liliaceae*.

*Trientalis arctica* (Arctic starflower). *Primulaceae*.

*Trisetum cernuum* (Nodding trisetum). *Poaceae*.

*Viola palustris* (Marsh violet). *Violaceae*.

## Mosses:

*Rhizomnium nudum*.

*Marchantia polymorpha* (Lung liverwort)

*Pellia neesiana* (Ring pellia).

## Fungi:

*Coltricia perennis* (Ground funnel). *Polyporaceae*. On charred or compacted ground.

*Cronartium ribicola* (White pine blister rust). *Cronartiaceae*. Infects 5-needle pines.

*Gymnopilus sp.* *Cortinariaceae*.

*Gymnosporangium nootkatense* (Cedar leaf blight; yellow cedar rust). *Pucciniaceae*. On *Sorbus*.

*Herpotrichia juniperi* (Snow mold; brown felt blight; black felt blight). *Pleosporaceae*. Infects conifers.

## Lichens:

*Cladina* (?) *rangiferina* (Gray reindeer lichen).

*Cladonia* sp.

*Sphaerophorus globosus* (Common Christmas-tree).

*Trapeliopsis granulosa* (Mottled disc lichen).
