Adi Ramot is one of the founders of NATAN and a long-standing member of the Board and professional management team. Adi is a member of Kibbutz Yotvata, in the southern Negev. Adi is a Registered Nurse and Public Health manager who also holds a master's degree in Risk and Disaster Management as well as a Master of Health Administration. In addition, Adi holds certificates in Trauma Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Medical Ethics and Mediation. Having devoted most of

her life to nursing and humanitarian causes, Adi personifies Natan's holistic approach to relief work. Adi was one of the initiators of NATAN's first disaster relief operation in Sri Lanka in 2004-2005. Following Sri Lanka, Adi headed several development projects in Sri Lanka, including the renovation of a girls' orphanage. In 2010, Adi led NATAN's earthquake relief operation in Haiti and later served in NATAN's Nepal operation following the earthquake in 2015. Adi is the founder of an international development organization, Eden Aid, which promotes human rights, women's rights and the rights of youth and children. Adi has pioneered women's empowerment groups in Sri Lanka and among the Bedouins in Southern Jordan.
