At the Annual Meeting held on June 16, 2024, there was a substantial amount of discussion concerning whether the Church will call a full time or part time settled pastor. Unfortunately many members have moved or passed away over the past several years resulting in an overall reduction in pledge income. While many members increased their pledges for the coming year, there is still a shortfall in the amount needed to pay a full time settled pastor. Therefore the budget as originally proposed called for a 3/4 time pastor. However, several members believe that the needs of this church necessitate a full time pastor. After speaking and listening to many opinions, church members voted to approve a budget calling for a full time settled pastor provided that an additional sum of \$27,500 be pledged by August 31, 2024. If this additional amount is not pledged by August 31, the budget will call for a 3/4 time settled pastor.

We invite you to prayerfully consider increasing your pledge amount.
