

Focus Group Logistics

Step 1) Parent Empowerment Workgroup identified locations and developed questions to ask the parents. First 1,000 Days team made flyers for each location to promote the parent focus groups.

Step 2) Selected facilitators and note takers for each location. It was best to have facilitators from the organization leading the group since families have trusted relationships with them. The list of questions was sent to facilitators beforehand so they could familiarize themselves with the script.

Step 3) Food and a \$25 gift card were provided for each participant. Some locations also provided childcare. Demographics were collected anonymously.

Step 4) Follow-up messages were sent to thank parents for participation and see if they needed any assistance connecting with community resources. Some parents desired to continue participation and joined our Parent Advisory Committee.
