





## **CSTIM: Circular Systems for Trims and Ignored Materials**

ACP launched a new working group, Circular Systems for Trims and Ignored Materials (CSTIM), in June 2023.

The group brings together major suppliers of trims, adhesives, thread, laminates, labels, and equipment to tackle the challenges of identifying, removing, and/or recycling these products in circular, textile-to-textile systems.

CSTIM will develop and publish recommendations to support scalable feedstock flows and quality to meet specifications for textile-to-textile recycling in the coming year.


