Hunter/Shooter Checklist

- The event takes place on **Saturday, October 3rd** at **Eckman's Shooting Preserve in Baldwin City, KS**
- Bring your hunter safety certificate the day of the event
- Wear a hunter/blaze orange vest and hat
- Bring your shotgun (unless you need to borrow one from us). Either way we'll provide ammunition
- Dress for the weather and wear hunting boots if you have them
- Bring along eye and ear protection
- We'll confirm your hunt time a few days prior to the event. You must show up at least 60 minutes prior to your scheduled hunt time for a required safety briefing and to shoot some warm up clays
- Youth hunters need to be accompanied by a mentor/parent/guardian
- Due to the ever changing COVID-19 situation, we will NOT be allowed to conduct or family fun activities this year. Under our current plan, you will arrive early for your hunt, go through a safety briefing, shoot some warm up clays and be able to enjoy your hunt. Currently, we are not planning on any of our traditional family activities, such as archery or the pellet gun range. A few light snacks and drinks will be available however we will be required to limit attendance to hunters/mentors only during your assigned time. Clubhouse will be limited entry to use the restroom only and no one else will be allowed to stay. No lunch or gun raffle will take place at this year's event. We look forward to bringing back our traditional youth hunt in the near future.
