



Worship and Praise

As we join in prayer together, let's meditate on what God has done for us, who we are in Christ, and where we pray from.

What God has done for us:

- The Father gave His only Son to pay for our sins in His body on the cross. Through faith in Christ, we die to sin and live to righteousness. Hallelujah! (**John 3:16, 1 Peter 2:24, 1 Peter 3:18, 2 Corinthians 5:21, Galatians 2:20**).
- When God reconciled us to Himself, He gave us the ministry of reconciliation. Now we are ambassadors for Christ and part of a holy and royal priesthood. (**2 Corinthians 5:20, 1 Peter 2:4-5, 2 Peter 1:3-4**).

Who we are in Christ:

- We are children of the Most-High God and joint-heirs with Christ (**Ephesians 1:3-6, Ephesians 2:19, Galatians 4:6-7, Romans 8:14-17**).
- We are more than conquerors in Christ and we have been given authority over the kingdom of darkness (**Romans 8:37, Colossians 2:15, Ephesians 1: 18-22, Ephesians 6:10-18, 2 Corinthians 10:3-5**).

Where we pray from:

- Because of Jesus Christ, we can literally pray from the heavenly realm, looking down on our earthly circumstances in victory (**Ephesians 2:4-6, Colossians 3:1-4, Hebrews 10:19-22**).
- In Christ, we can pray from the very throne room of God, ushering heaven to this earth through our prayers and faith (**Hebrews 4:16, Hebrews 11:6, Matthew 6:10, Matthew 6:33, Ephesians 3:10-12**).

Prayer Points

Prayer points have been provided to help you in your time of intercession but remember—**prayer is relationship**. The Holy Spirit wants to lead, guide, and share His heart with you during this time. Thank you for your faithfulness and your powerful prayers!

Repentance:

- Personal repentance for our own sin (let the Holy Spirit search and lead).
- Repenting on behalf of our family (let the Holy Spirit point out generational sin that we need to bring before our Heavenly Father for healing and deliverance).
- Repenting on behalf of the Body of Christ (let us repent for relying on our own wisdom, not the Holy Spirit to lead and guide us, and not fully appreciating/appropriating all that Christ suffered and won for us).
- Let us repent for not faithfully stewarding all that God has entrusted to us (our culture, communities, schools, government, media, nation).
- Let us stand in the gap and repent on behalf of our nation's leaders (all branches of government, federal, state, and local).

Agreement:

- Let's agree with God that His ways are perfect.
- Let's agree with God that He is absolute truth.
- Let's agree with God's Word and choose to submit our lives to its authority.
- Let's agree with what God declares to be evil.
- Let's agree with God that our nation has failed to protect the unborn.
- Let's agree with God that we have not walked in the fear of the Lord.
- Let's agree with God that we have allowed idolatry in our land.
- Let's agree with God that His ways are better, higher, and purer.
- Let's agree with God that we need Him and can do nothing without Him.
- Let's agree that we long for a fresh outpouring of His Holy Spirit.
- Let's agree that we want His Kingdom to come and His will to be done on earth.
as it is in heaven

Affirmation:

- Let's affirm that we want God's will to be done on earth.
- Let's affirm that we "vote" in heaven for righteousness.
- Let's affirm that we "vote" in heaven for the unborn that cannot protect themselves.
- Let's affirm that we "vote" in heaven for Israel to be supported, blessed, and protected.
- Let's affirm that we will also vote on earth for candidates that embrace those things that represent our Father's heart (e.g., protecting the unborn and standing with Israel).
- Let's affirm that we want righteousness in our nation.
- Let's affirm that we want corruption uncovered and justice executed.
- Let's affirm that we want leaders that will bless and show favor to Israel and the Body of Christ.

Proclamation:

- Let's proclaim that we cut off the demonic forces and powers at the root with the axe of righteousness and we forbid them access to our nation's leaders in Jesus' mighty name.
- Let's proclaim that we are awake to the truth that we are children of God, joint-heirs in Christ and mighty warriors in the Kingdom of God.
- Let's proclaim that we embrace the fear of the Lord and choose to yield to holy fire (consume, refine, and purify our lives King Jesus).
- Let's proclaim that Roe v. Wade will be overturned in Jesus' mighty name.
- Let's proclaim that righteousness will once again exalt this nation.
- Let's proclaim that we forsake all false gods.
- Let's proclaim that we will take accountability for the stewardship we've been entrusted with (our culture, communities, schools, government, media, nation).
- Let's proclaim we embrace the cross and choose the crucified life that we might know the power of His resurrection.
- Let's proclaim that we are ready to fully embrace all that Christ won for us and no longer limit His work in our lives (deliverance, healing, resurrection power).
- Let's proclaim that Christ is worthy of our highest praises.
- Let's proclaim that we fully surrender to our glorious King of kings.
- Let's proclaim the prodigals are coming home in Jesus' mighty name.
- Let's proclaim that we want to be made a pure and spotless Bride.
- Let's proclaim that we want to depend on the Holy Spirit and not ourselves.
- Let's proclaim that nothing is impossible with God.
- Let's proclaim that our nation will walk in the fear of the Lord once again.
- Let's proclaim that we are not ashamed of the gospel of Jesus Christ.
- Let's proclaim that we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken — Hallelujah!
