Introduction to All Kids Belong (AKB)

This course is appropriate for anyone working in a licensed child care program or before and after school care program. It covers the basics of what AKB can offer, and tips on how we can work effectively together.

Program Assistant Orientation for New Program Assistants

If you are providing Program Assistant supports through All Kids Belong funding, this course is for you! It explains the processes involved, the role of the program assistant, and who to contact if you have questions.

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Program Assistant Orientation for Classroom Educators and Supervisors

This course covers all of the processes involved in requesting Program Assistant support, an overview of the agreements and paperwork that must be in place, and tips on how we can all work effectively together.

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School Age Program Resources

You already know how to run a great school age program, but it can be challenging to meet the diverse needs of children in those programs. This course is full of videos, tip sheets, and other resources to help you meet that challenge. We encourage you to access this course in the way that best suits your needs: you can skip ahead to a topic of interest, use a portion of the course to generate discussion at team meetings, or just print resources on an as-needed basis.

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Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)

This course is appropriate for anyone working in a licensed child care program or before and after school care program. It covers the basics of what ASD is, possible indicators of ASD (communication, social, behavioural), inclusive settings, practical strategies to support children with ASD, and many other resources.

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Connection

This course looks at the importance of connection. Through connection, we will be able to help the children we work with explore, learn and develop. Relationship is key to happy and healthy development in children.

Stress Behaviour vs. Misbehaviour

As educators we see so many different behaviours and we know that behaviour is a way of communicating. This course looks at two "categories" of behaviour – misbehaviour and stress behaviour – and why it is critical to understand the distinction between the two. This course is based on Dr. Stuart Shanker's Self Reg.

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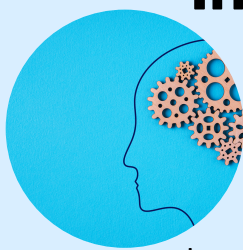


The Senses and Heavy Play

This course provides information about senses (a refresher) and exploring proprioception, sensory processing and heavy play. It also includes additional resources for educators.

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Trauma and Trauma Informed Care



This course explores trauma and trauma informed care – what it is, and why taking this approach is so beneficial for the children (and adults) we work with.
