FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS

1

children

Fac will often ask parents, SW & RCG to share how the children are doing. It is helpful to bring information on the following:

- Who children's PCP/Dentist are & current health, dates of last appointment or upcoming, what school they attend and grade, extracurricular activities, mental health, services they are involved in & any concerns

2

family strengths

Family, SW, GAL/CASA & providers are often asked to share some family strengths they have noticed while working with the family. Ex: Family showing up to the conference with lots of support

3


help & services

Providers are asked to explain their program, expectations, if parent already began services please share date started, and how many sessions to complete program & how often do you meet & progress or challenges. If provider is meeting the parents for the first time at the OC, often provider & parents will schedule a date, time & location for the initial intake

4

visits

Fac will be asking how visits are going. Often the SW will provide updates & sometimes RCG or provider will share if they help supervise visits. Be prepared to share the following:
