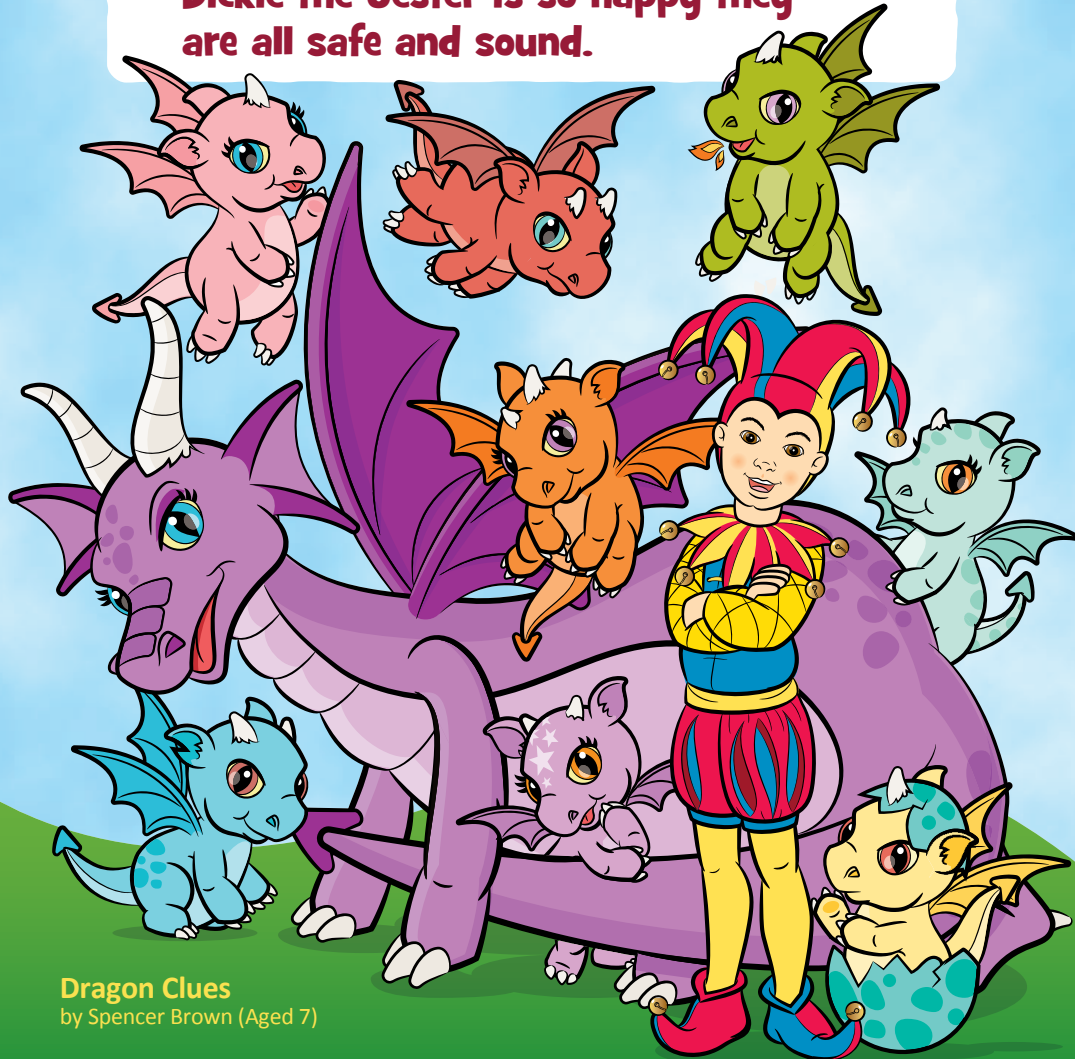

to find.

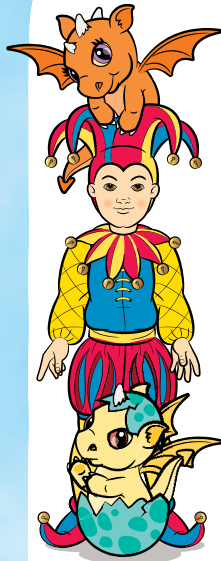
Keep looking
