Blair will advocate for:

- Healthcare and the financial resources to plan and start a family
- Family leave so women can spend those critical early weeks caring for newborns
- Raising medicaid wage cap, expanding healthcare to more women suffering financial hardship
- Legislation for universal basic income, a “Freedom Dividend” that will be a benefit to all Americans, but will have the greatest impact on those who live paycheck to paycheck, and will support mothers everywhere as well as ensuring that all children have basic needs met
- Improving access to affordable and accessible women’s health centers, including prenatal care and pediatrics
- Providing access to high-quality guaranteed childcare modelled on the military
- Ensuring birth control is affordable and easily accessible and that school curriculum includes sex education



On Abortion, Blair says, “I believe in the sanctity of all lives, and the best way to take on abortion is by addressing the reasons why women make that tragic choice.
