How to use this list

Parents often find it easier to navigate conversations about sexuality when they don't have to come up with the words, definitions, or explanations on their own. Books can be a great tool for introducing new sexuality topics to kids.

Instead of giving your child a book to read on their own, read the book with your child and be there to process what you read together. Some of the things you can ask include:

- What do you think about what we read?
- What questions do you have about what we read?
- Emphasize your values as you read, for example, "It's never okay to touch someone without their permission" or "It's okay to feel angry, what matters are the choices you make when you feel that way."

As a reminder, always read the books first and determine if they're a fit for your family. Talk More will continue to update this list with new recommendations.


