

Established in 1888, Champion Mill is the last functional water-powered mill in Nebraska. Started by T. Scott, the mill has changed ownership many times but is now run by Chase County. The area is used for recreation, picnics, non-motor boats, fishing, swimming, ice skating and S.C.O.R.E. Camp is held here. The mill building is open for tours. Call 308-882-5860 for details.


