EU Responsible Person Services

Each cosmetic product placed on the EU market must be allocated a Responsible person. Yordas Group offers Responsible Person services for cosmetic products, where we:

- Take responsibility for the products' regulatory compliance
- Manage associated regulatory obligations for your products (e.g. post-marketing surveillance)
- Communicate with competent authorities

Compliance Documents and Reports

Yordas Group can create, maintain and store regulatory reports and assessment documentation required for your cosmetic product compliance around the world.

For example, in the EU the Cosmetic Products Regulation requires the following to be prepared and stored:

- The Product Information File (PIF)

 Contains information on the product and its production
- Cosmetic Product Safety Report (CPSR) - Contains information derived from scientific reviews to demonstrate the safety of the cosmetic product

EU Cosmetic Product Notification Roadmap

To market a cosmetic product in compliance with the Cosmetic Products Regulation (Regulation (EC) N° 1223/2009) involves a number of steps which have been outlined in the form of this EU regulatory roadmap:

1. Scoping Assessment

First, Yordas can conduct a Cosmetics Scoping Assessment to determine if the product is considered a cosmetic product in the relevant regulatory landscape.

2. Assign Responsible Person

A Responsible Person is a legal or natural person based in EU. This person is responsible for ensuring compliance of the cosmetics products. Yordas Group offers Responsible Person services.

3. Formulation Review

Yordas can conduct a formulation review to ensure the product does not contain prohibited substances and that there are no ingredients above limits set out by the regulation. A review of the toxicological profile of each ingredient is also conducted.

4. Create a Product Information File (PIF)

Yordas Group can generate PIF files and hold them for cosmetic products as the Responsible Person. The PIF includes the following information:

- Description of cosmetic product
- Cosmetic Product Safety Report (CPSR)
- Product is evaluated to ensure it is safe for use
- Must be carried out by a qualified safety assessor
- Method of manufacture and statement on GMP

compliance

- Proof of effect claimed by the cosmetic product, with a substantiation of all claims
- Data on animal testing

5. Labelling

Yordas can create compliant labels, including translation to required languages.



6. CPNP Notification

The Cosmetic Product Notification Portal (CPNP) is the online notification system used to notify the European Commission for the relevant territory. Prior to placing a product on the market, specific information must be notified to the Commission electronically through means of the CPNP. The Commission then makes this information available to the competent authorities.

7. Placing Product on the Market

Following the successful completion of the previous steps, the product may be placed on the market. It should be noted that placing the product on the market may be subject to additional requirements depending on the territories selected.

8. Active Post-Marketing Surveillance

The Responsible Person manages the post-marketing surveillance. Part of this activity requires the PIF to be retained for 10 years after the product has been removed from the market.

Safety Assessments Explained

Before a product can be placed on the market it must undergo a safety assessment by a qualified professional.

Yordas Group's safety assessor can assess your products to generate the Cosmetic Products Safety Report (CPSR). This assessment takes into account the toxicological profile and the exposure level for each ingredient while considering the intended place where the cosmetic product will be applied (e.g. face, body etc) and for how long. Additionally, the assessment in the CPSR considers the type of persons for whom the product is intended (e.g. children, adults etc).

Post-Market Surveillance Explained

Post-Market Surveillance is in force for cosmetic products on the EU market to protect the health of consumers. Surveillance is conducted by the Responsible Person using a harmonised approach to investigate, document and report incidents of undesirable effects relating to cosmetic products use.

Our post-market surveillance activities also include monitoring of regulatory changes that may impact the conditions for which your cosmetic product may be placed on the market within defined territories.
