Bongo Fury build & BOM

A triple version of the BongO, one of those simple modules that pumps out way more character than it should.

The changes are only minor; the trimpot has been replaced with a 75k resistor (marked 75k* on PCB), I found I always set the trimpot to the same position, so it seemed redundant, feel free to vary it if you wish to make the circuit easily self-oscillate or not do so at all.

Also there are pads for installing 5V1 zener diodes to prevent the outputs going rail to rail when things get going. These are optional, the original version works fine without them, tho I would suggest installing them on maybe 2 of the sections and leave the third untethered. The reason for them is the Bongo output can be quite varied, at some settings the signal is small, down to +/-2V, at others it is +/-10V, so the zeners keep it to a max of approx. +/-5V making things easier to control downstream in your patch.

C1, C2 & C3 set the operating range for each Bongo. Easiest is to just install 100n which gives a good spread. For higher freq try 10n or 22n or 47n, for lower try 150n or 220n, tho there will be a sub-audio range if you do.

Additional notes:

<u>1.</u>, Schottky (best option) **or** standard power rectifier diode 50-600V 1A or more, **or** use a resettable fuse **or** just a 10R. Examples: BAT54GWX, PMEG2005EGWX, AEC-Q101, 20V, SOD-123, PMEG2005EH DIODE, SCHOTTKY, 0.5A, 20V, 1N400x or S1JL or similar.

2. The chips, resistors, caps are cheapest from Tayda. Schottky diodes, CMOS & 1uF, 10uF 25V 0805 caps from Mouser/E14/Farnell/etc.
