**Requirements:** Meets the Intercultural Education Field Experience requirement for state cert students, an elective for the master's (with EDT 567 Intro to Intercultural Education) or the EDT 508 Observation requirement

**Cost:** \$1900 **The fee does NOT include airfare, airport transfer fees or food**

Montessori students can travel to Seville to complete the intercultural immersion field experience requirement and/or 60 observation hours in a bilingual English language immersion program at an AMI affiliated school. We will stay in the heart of Seville for close access to the city's historical sights and cultural events. This trip is a great opportunity to be immersed in the Spanish culture, language, and schools.

## The \$1900 trip fee covers the following:

### Housing

- Lodging in Seville

### Transportation
