A MESSAGE FROM RABBI MARK SCHIFTAN

Our prayer book, Mishkan T'filah, offers a moving image of how we might remember and be inspired by our loved ones, even in the shadow of their loss from our midst. These words comprise an introduction to the themes of the Kaddish prayer:

*There are stars up above,
so far away we only see their light
long, long after the star itself is gone.
And so it is with people that we loved—
their memories keep shining ever brightly*

*though their time with us is done.
But the stars that light up the darkest night,
these are the lights that guide us.
As we live our days, these are the ways we remember (them).*

At this time of year, and at this hour of the day, in particular, on the Day of Atonement, we feel, perhaps, an even deeper connection with our loved ones and an even greater longing to have their presence still with us in our lives.

We remember both the sound of their laughter and how they made us laugh, as well;
the comfort of their touch, and the strength that their embrace gave to us.
We recall the softness and the honesty of the words they spoke to us,
even as we reflect on the essence of those words
and the meaning of all that they taught us, by word as well as by deed.

At this hour of Yizkor, of Remembrance, even as we acknowledge how much the lives of our loved ones still mean to us, even in memory,

And how very much we still miss them and their presence in every moment of our lives, let us challenge ourselves, nonetheless, to give thanks for the gift from God, for the time we shared with them.

And let us take comfort in the knowledge that, like the stars that shine above, even on the darkest nights, our loved ones continue to illuminate our lives, offering comfort, hope and a sign that their presence continues to lead the way for us, even on the darkest of nights, or at the loneliest of times along life's path.
May they be remembered for a blessing. Amen.

A MESSAGE FROM RABBI MICHAEL SHULMAN

Rabbi Morris Adler challenges us with these essential questions at this time of reflection, seeking and memory:

Who among us has not at one time or another known the sharp pain of grief, the poignant hurt of loss?
Who has been able to insulate himself against the slings and arrows of outrageous fortune or escape the disappointment and melancholy to which human flesh is heir?
Is there anyone here to whom sadness is strange and anguish alien?
Is there an individual from whom life has not wrung tears or whose lips have never uttered a sigh?

Every mortal has a date with adversity, loss and death... If there is one experience that is common to all, then it is sorrow.

An old and familiar story illustrates the universality of sadness. A patient came to a physician in the city of Naples. He complained of melancholia. He could not rid himself of a deep feeling of sadness. The physician said: "I advise you to visit the theatre where the incomparable Carlini is appearing. This great comedian daily convulses large crowds with laughter. By all means go to see Carlini. His amusing antics will drive away your melancholy. "At these words the patient burst into tears and sobbed: "But doctor, I am Carlini..."

This awareness that sorrow is our common lot will not restore a lost one, or heal an ailment. It should, however, save us from an outpouring of that self-pity to which we would succumb were we to feel that none has ever suffered as we.

A MESSAGE FROM CANTOR TRACY FISHBEIN

Rabbi Naomi Levy writes,

“Death cannot sever our connection to those we have lost. The soul is eternal and can never be extinguished. But not only the soul survives the grave. The bonds of love are stronger than death. The lessons that our loved ones taught us, their goodness, their deeds, their wisdom will remain with us always. They have left a permanent imprint upon our souls that can never be erased. They continue to guide us wherever we go.”

In this season of repentance and remembrance, the absence of our loved ones is especially profound. We recall with love - and sometimes, a tinge of sadness - the many gifts and lessons that those we've loved have so graciously shared with us. May the loving presence of our departed ones guide us always, and may their memories lead us to lives of blessing in the coming year.

A MESSAGE FROM PRESIDENT JIMMY MARKS

The Yom Kippur Yizkor service evokes strong memories for me. Growing up in Savannah, Georgia I attended the service with my mother at Mikve Israel, one of the oldest congregations in the country. For those of you who have not visited Mikve Israel, it is located on Monterrey Square and it's exterior is of Moorish design. The interior looks like a church with its vaulted ceilings. The plastered walls and columns provide a rich creamy white interior.

I remember during the Yom Kippur Yizkor service the afternoon light would stream through the stained glass windows casting a golden hue to the sanctuary. Dust particles which you would not notice during the white light of day would shimmer like floating glitter. There was a solemn tone to the service which was only interrupted by the haunting beauty of El Nora Alila. These images and sounds I carry with me and think of them each year during this service.

Yizkor has the power to remind us of people who were a part of our lives but are no longer with us. Perhaps we do not feel their presence in the bright white light of the everyday; but Yizkor shines a golden light which illuminates their presence like the glittering dust floating in the air. At Yizkor we remember them and assure them that they will not be forgotten or stopped being loved.

THE SIGNIFICANCE OF YIZKOR

Yizkor was originally a prayer that appears to have its origins in Germany. Although the origins of Yizkor and its recitations are unclear, its primary purpose was to commemorate the Jewish martyrs slain during the First and Second Crusades. In time, this origin was forgotten, but the warmth and nostalgia of remembrance grew important. Prayers of remembrance became a part of Jewish ritual.

Few ceremonies in Jewish life are more powerful in meaning than this Memorial Service. It is a time to remember those loved ones who have passed beyond the threshold of life and into the great space of eternity. It is a time to thank God for the lives of our loved ones no longer with us. It is a time to give homage to those who made the world a better place because they lived in it. It is a time to strengthen the bonds between the here and the hereafter in the hearts and minds of those who survive their departed.
