

Caring for your concrete pavers is a relatively simple process to incorporate into your maintenance routine.

Additional steps can be implemented down the road as needed to maintain the pavers and much like a natural stone your pavers can be rejuvenated with an abrasive wet-scrub & seal; our concrete pavers are made of naturally occurring raw materials and as such patina is expected with age.

routine care

- wipe up spills as they occur giving immediate attention to acidic liquids like lemon juice.
- pressure wash as needed.
- for more aggressive scrub - light duty masonry cleaner like prosoco sure klean & bristle brush.

down the road

- reapply sealer per sealer manufacturer's recommendations using a sealer-dampened micro-fiber towel.
- prosoco slx100 is our recommended sealer and can be purchased directly or through concrete collaborative.

future rejuvenation

- wet-scrub floor with a floor machine using warm water & htc twister™ pad red
- for more aggressive scrub - light duty masonry cleaner like prosoco sure klean & bristle brush.
- work in sections and be diligent in removing dirty water before drying.
- apply a couple of thin coats of slx100 sealer or (owner's preferred sealer) following manufacturer's instructions.
- wipe-off excess sealer using a microfiber to maintain a natural finish.
- allow appropriate cure time for sealer prior to use.
