



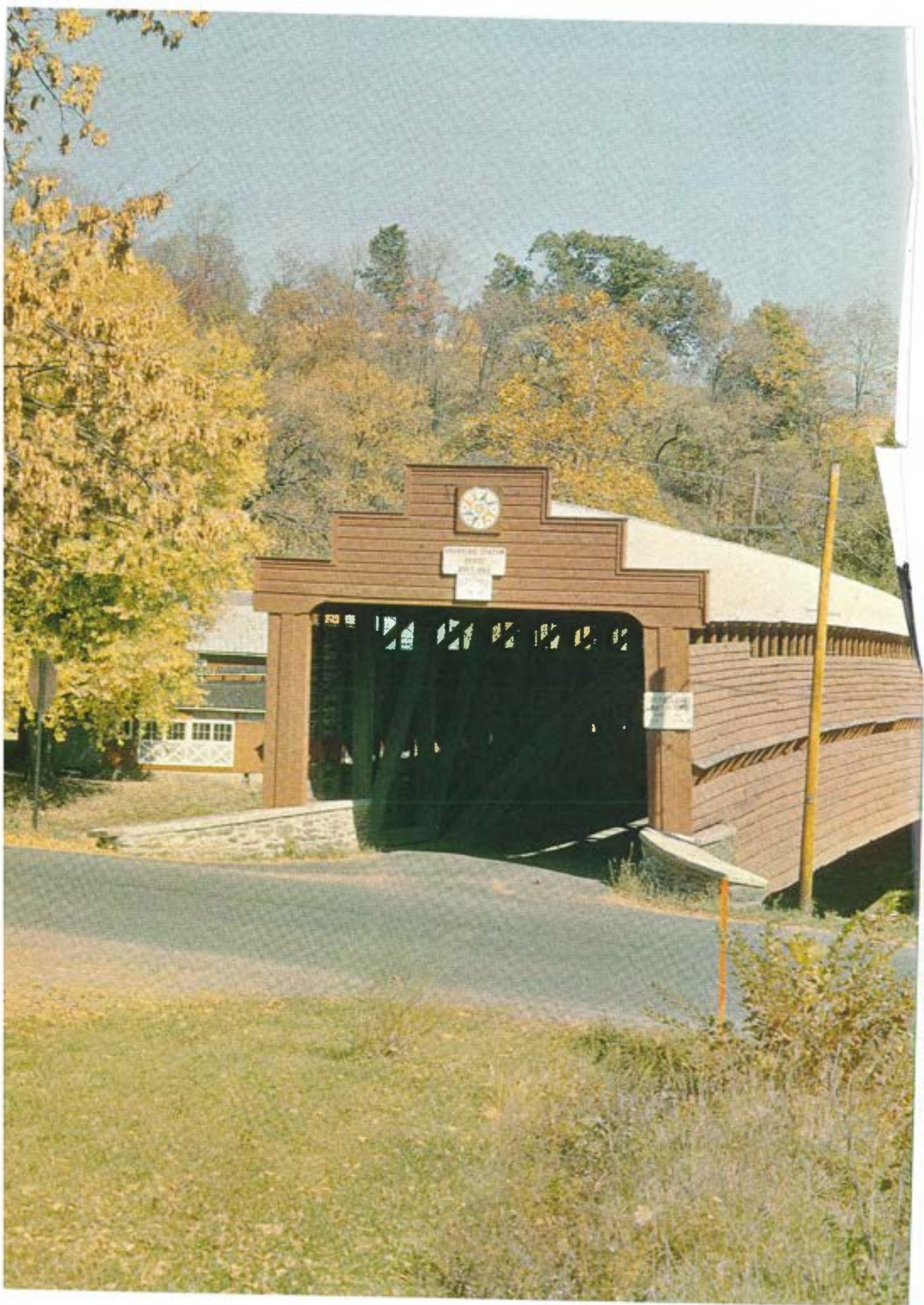

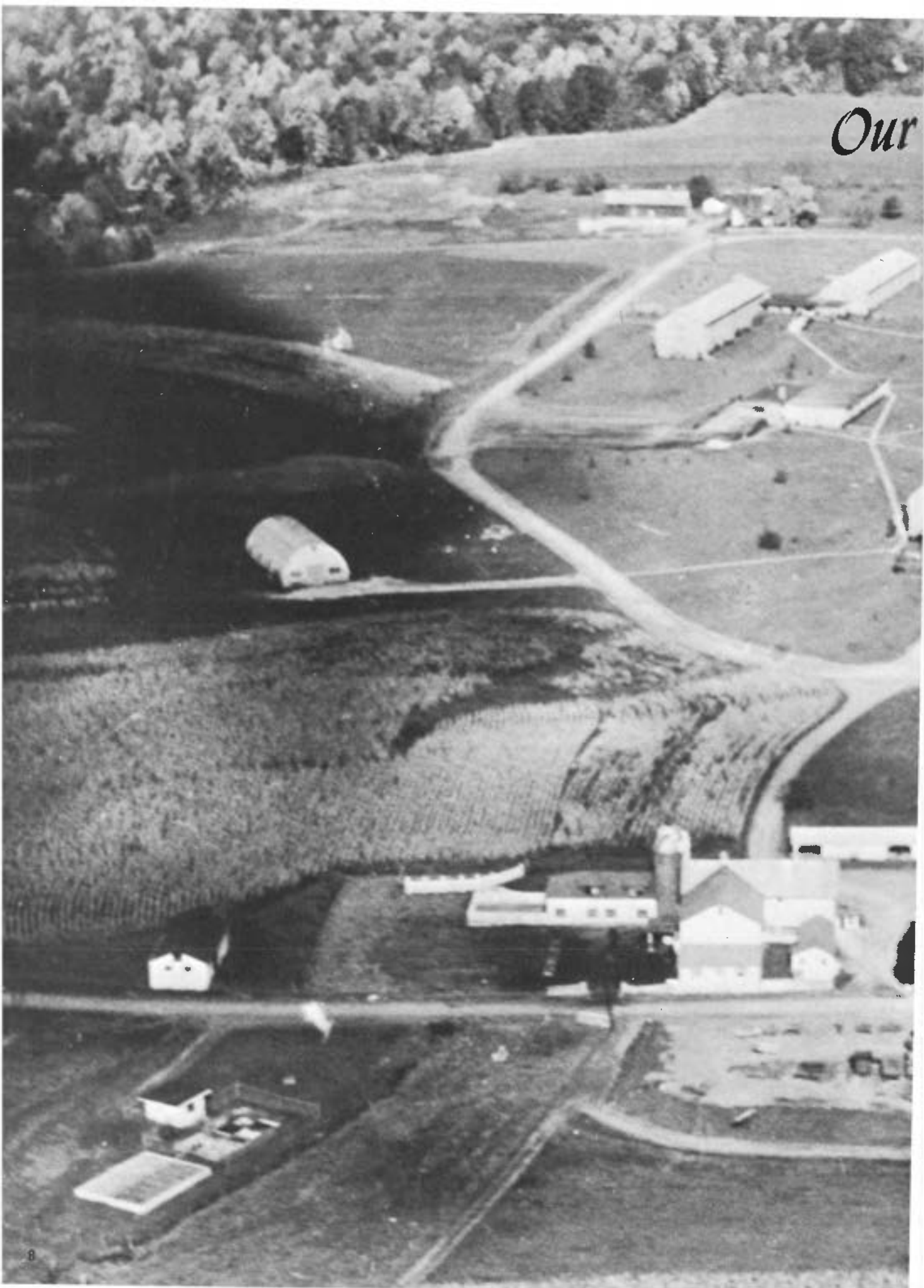


# *Dedication*
