SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT IN DBKIDS: CURRICULUM

dbKids' Mission is to partner alongside parents and guardians to influence kids to become fully devoted followers of Christ. In all we do, we strive to be intentional with what we teach in dbKids. This month we'll be looking at the curriculums utilized in dbKids.

NURSERY -

Age 0 through 3 years old.

In these early years we want kiddos and families to adjust to being in dbKids. We teach the "God Made" curriculum (created by dbKids staff), the foundation of God as Creator. This curriculum repeats every year.

PRESCHOOL & ELEMENTARY -

3 years old through 4th grade.

By this age we want kiddos and families fully adjusted and comfortable being in dbKids. These classes study "The Gospel Project" by Lifeway. This curriculum goes through the Bible every 3 years and gets kids familiar with the major stories of the Bible, always pointing it back to the Gospel Message.

UPPER ELEMENTARY -

5th & 6th grade.

During 1st service this class meets with 3rd/4th grade to study "The Gospel Project". 2nd service they have their own classroom which uses "Forged" by Lifeway. This curriculum moves from the stories of the Bible and Gospel Message to refining and having kiddos ask hard questions about what they believe (ie. What is Truth?).

3 Tips for Reading Out Loud to Your Child:

- 2. Ask questions about what you just read.
- 3. Build it into the family routine.
