



Quarter System Schedule

South Hill operates on a quarter term system, where students may enter in September, November, February or April

- there are 4 quarters of study; 9 weeks per quarter
- students study 2 academic courses per quarter
- classes run for 2 hours, 15 minutes per day, M-F
- this offers students the advantage of completing courses in 9 weeks, thus progressing through high school graduation requirements at a faster pace
- summer term runs for approx. 5 weeks, from July to Aug, for 3.5 hours per day. Students study 1 course in this time period
