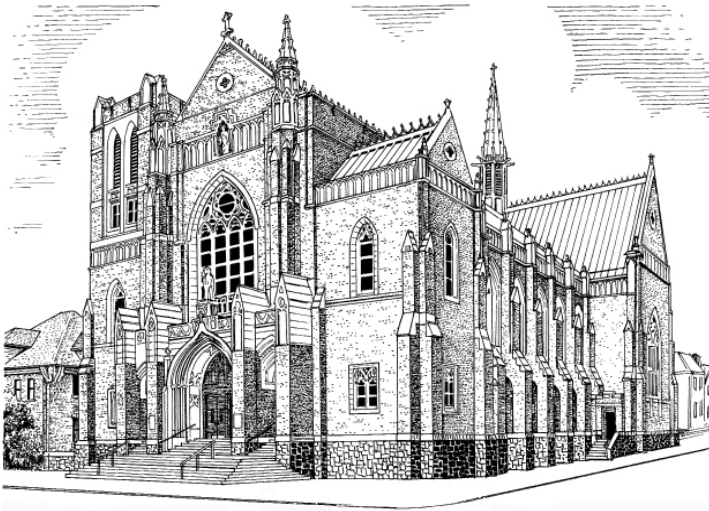

## Sacraments at Our Parish

### Baptism | Bautismo:



Baptism is the first sacrament of initiation through which one becomes part of the Body of Christ, the Catholic Church. We usually celebrate Baptism on the last weekend of each month. To schedule one, contact the Rectory **a month or more** before to speak with a priest.

### Alleluia, the Lord is risen! Alleluia

My dear brothers and sisters, after 40 days of walking through the desert, praying, fasting, and overcoming temptations, after 40 days of going through the mountains and allowing ourselves to be transfigured by the Lord, after 40 days of going to the temple and recognizing the importance of the place of encounter with our God through reflection, prayer, after 40 days of going to Jesus, after 40 days of prayer, penance, sacrifices, reconciliation, charity, fasting, reflections, talks, confessions, we finally arrive at this glorious day. The day our Christian Catholic Church is inviting us to experience and live the resurrection of Jesus. Without a doubt, depending on each of us who lived this Lenten season, we can now enjoy and rejoice in the Easter season. Now we find that the tomb is empty, that Jesus did not remain on the cross, much less in the tomb; he has risen and, with his resurrection, offers us life, salvation, eternal life, and resurrection. The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us that: "We firmly believe, and so hope, that just as Christ has indeed risen from the dead, and lives forever, so the righteous after their death will live forever with the resurrected Christ and that He will resurrect them on the last day (cf. Jn. 6, 39-40). Like his, our resurrection will be the work of the Holy Trinity: "If the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit that dwells in you (Rom. 8, 11) (CCC No. 989).

Dear brothers and sisters, the resurrection is not a fact or event only Jesus experienced. All of us who believe in Jesus also wait for the resurrection of the last day. Still, when that day arrives, we are called to live the resurrection from our experience of faith, from our experience of sacramental grace, and the practice of the commandments and teachings of Jesus. That is why we were working during Lent: to reach this Easter day and with Jesus to be new and resurrected men and women. This experience of the resurrection invites us first to go to the tomb and, like Mary Magdalene, to realize that Jesus is alive and not in the tomb. We have to run like Peter and John and believe; we have to run and announce that Jesus has risen, but our own life has to believe it, live it, and share it. Perhaps like the apostles, we too do not understand much; remember that the things of God are not understood from reason but are lived and understood from the heart because it is only through our experience of faith that we can understand.

Let us go to the tomb. Let us see that Jesus is not dead and that his body is not there. Let us believe that Jesus is the God of life and that he has conquered sin, evil, and death itself. Let us run to communicate the joy of being sons and daughters of God, the joy of being followers of Jesus, and the joy of being members of our Catholic Church. Let us run to announce that He rose again for our salvation and that now we are called to be resurrected men and women who, with our life of faith, with our daily life, live the grace of being men and women of God, men and women of Jesus, men and women resurrected.

### Aleluya, el ¡Señor ha resucitado! Aleluya

Mis queridos hermanos y hermanas, después de 40 días de caminar por el desierto, orar, ayunar y vencer las tentaciones, de ir por la montaña y dejarnos transfigurar por el Señor, de ir al templo y reconocer la importancia del lugar de encuentro con nuestro Dios por la reflexión, la oración, después de 40 días de oración, penitencia, sacrificios, reconciliación, ayuda generosa, ayuno, reflexiones, charlas, confesiones etc. etc., finalmente llegamos a este día glorioso, el día que todo el cristianismo católico somos invitados a vivir la resurrección de Jesús. Sin duda que dependiendo de cada uno de nosotros vivió este tiempo cuaresmal, podemos ahora disfrutar y gozar del tiempo pascual. Ahora nos encontramos con que el sepulcro está vacío, que Jesús no se quedó en la cruz, y mucho menos se quedó en la tumba, EL ha resucitado y con su resurrección nos ofrece la vida, la salvación, la vida eterna, la resurrección. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos dice que: "Creemos firmemente, y así lo esperamos, que del mismo modo que Cristo ha resucitado verdaderamente de entre los muertos, y que vive para siempre, igualmente los justos después de su muerte vivirán para siempre con Cristo resucitado y que Él los resucitará en el último día (cf. Jn. 6, 39-40). Como la suya, nuestra resurrección será obra de la Santísima Trinidad: «Si el Espíritu de Aquel que resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos habita en vosotros, Aquel que resucitó a Jesús de entre los muertos dará también la vida a vuestros cuerpos mortales por su Espíritu que habita en vosotros (Rm. 8, 11) (CIC No. 989).

Queridos hermanos y hermanas, la resurrección no es un hecho o acontecimiento que vivió solo Jesús, todos los que creemos en Jesús esperamos también la resurrección del último día, pero mientras ese día llega, como llamados a vivir la resurrección desde nuestra experiencia de la fe, desde nuestra vivencia de la gracia sacramental, desde la práctica del mandamiento y enseñanzas de Jesús, por ello estuvimos trabajando durante la cuaresma, para llegar a este día pascual y con Jesús ser hombres y mujeres nuevos, resucitados. Esta vivencia de la resurrección nos invita primero a ir al sepulcro y como María Magdalena darnos cuenta de que Jesús está vivo, que él, no está en el sepulcro, tenemos que correr como Pedro y Juan y creer, tenemos que correr y anunciar que Jesús ha resucitado, pero es nuestra misma vida quien tiene que creerlo, vivirlo y compartirlo. Tal vez como los apóstoles también nosotros no comprendemos mucho, recuerden que las cosas de Dios no se comprenden desde la razón, sino que son cosas que viven y se entienden desde el corazón, porque es única y solamente experiencia de fe.

Vayamos al sepulcro, veamos que Jesús no está muerto, que su cuerpo no está ahí, creamos que Jesús es el Dios de la vida, y que el ha vencido al pecado, al mal, a la misma muerte, corramos a comunicar la alegría de ser hijos e hijas de Dios, la alegría de ser seguidores, seguidoras de Jesús, la alegría de ser miembros de nuestra Iglesia católica, corramos a anunciar que el resucito para nuestra salvación, y que ahora somos llamados a ser hombres y mujeres resucitados, quienes con nuestra vida de fe, con nuestra vida diaria vivimos la gracia de ser hombres y mujeres de Dios, hombres y mujeres de Dios, hombres y mujeres resucitados.


